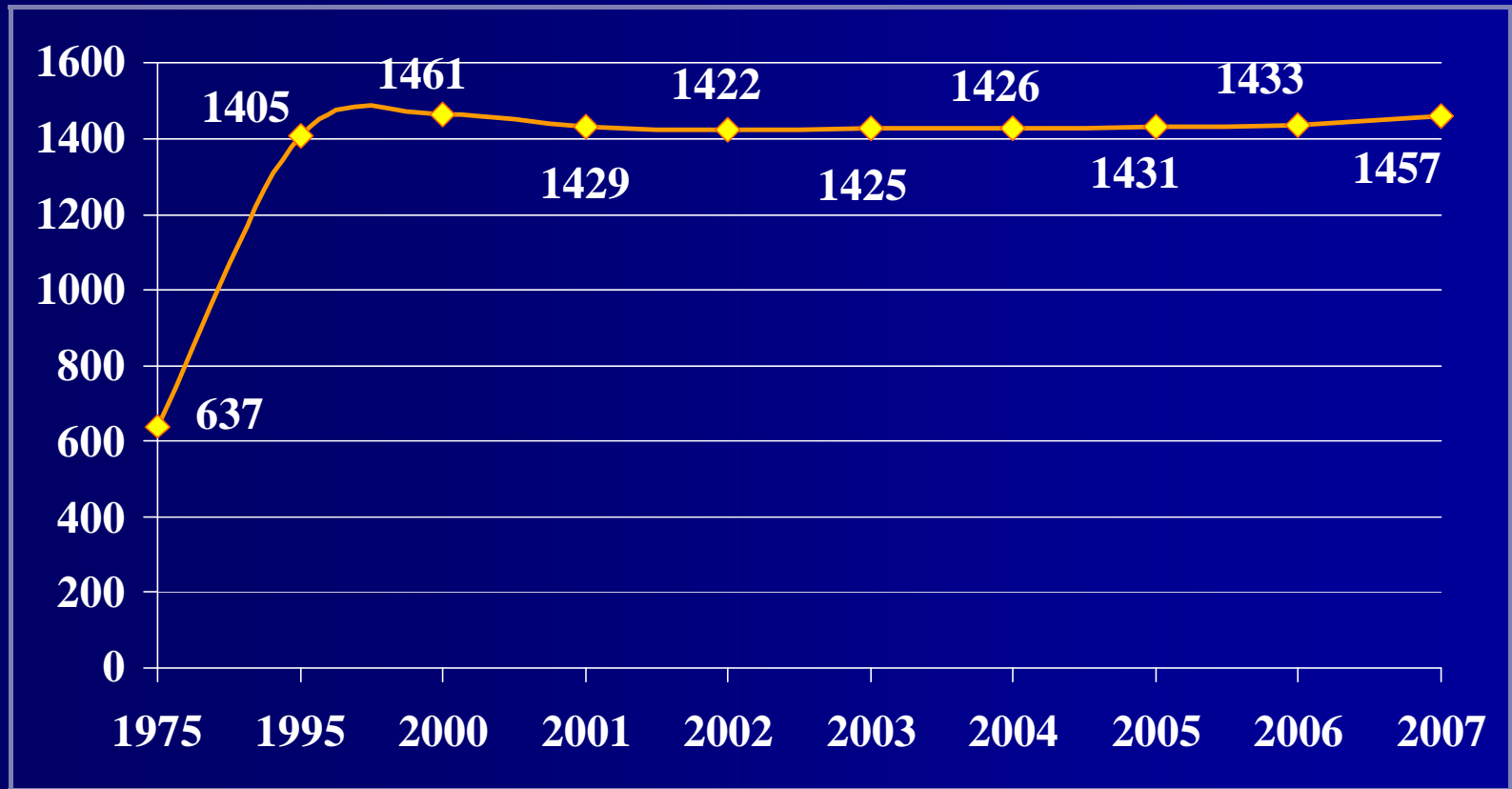
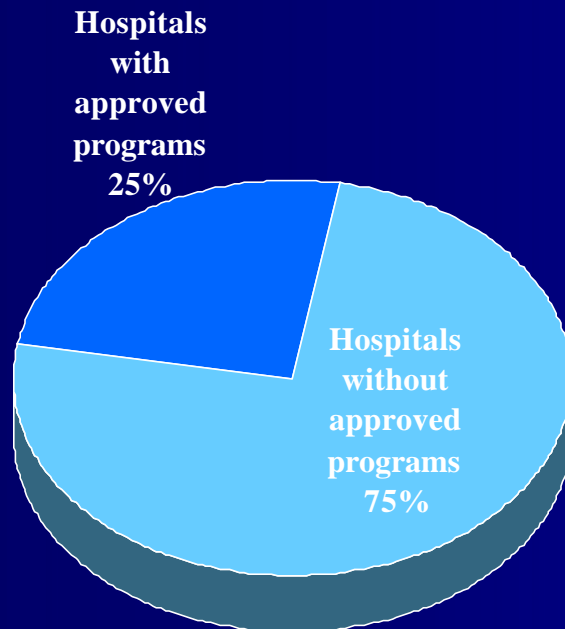

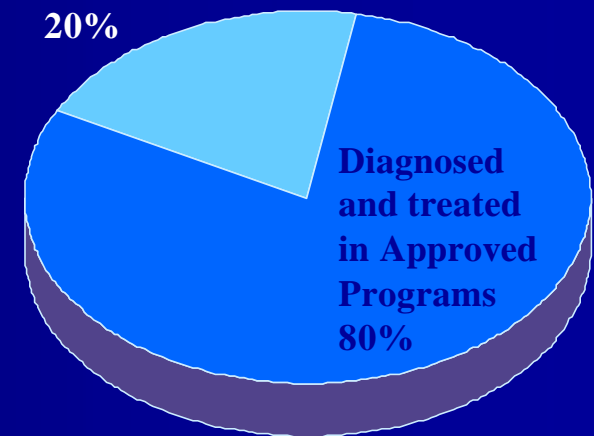

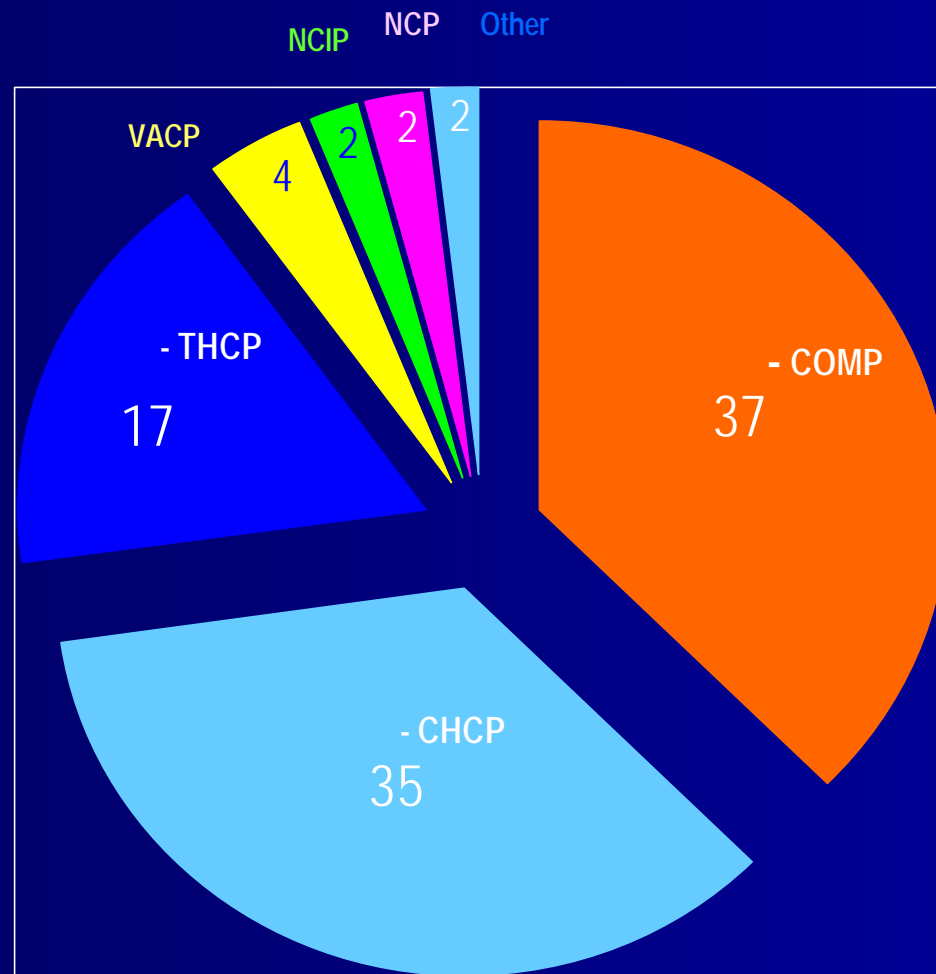

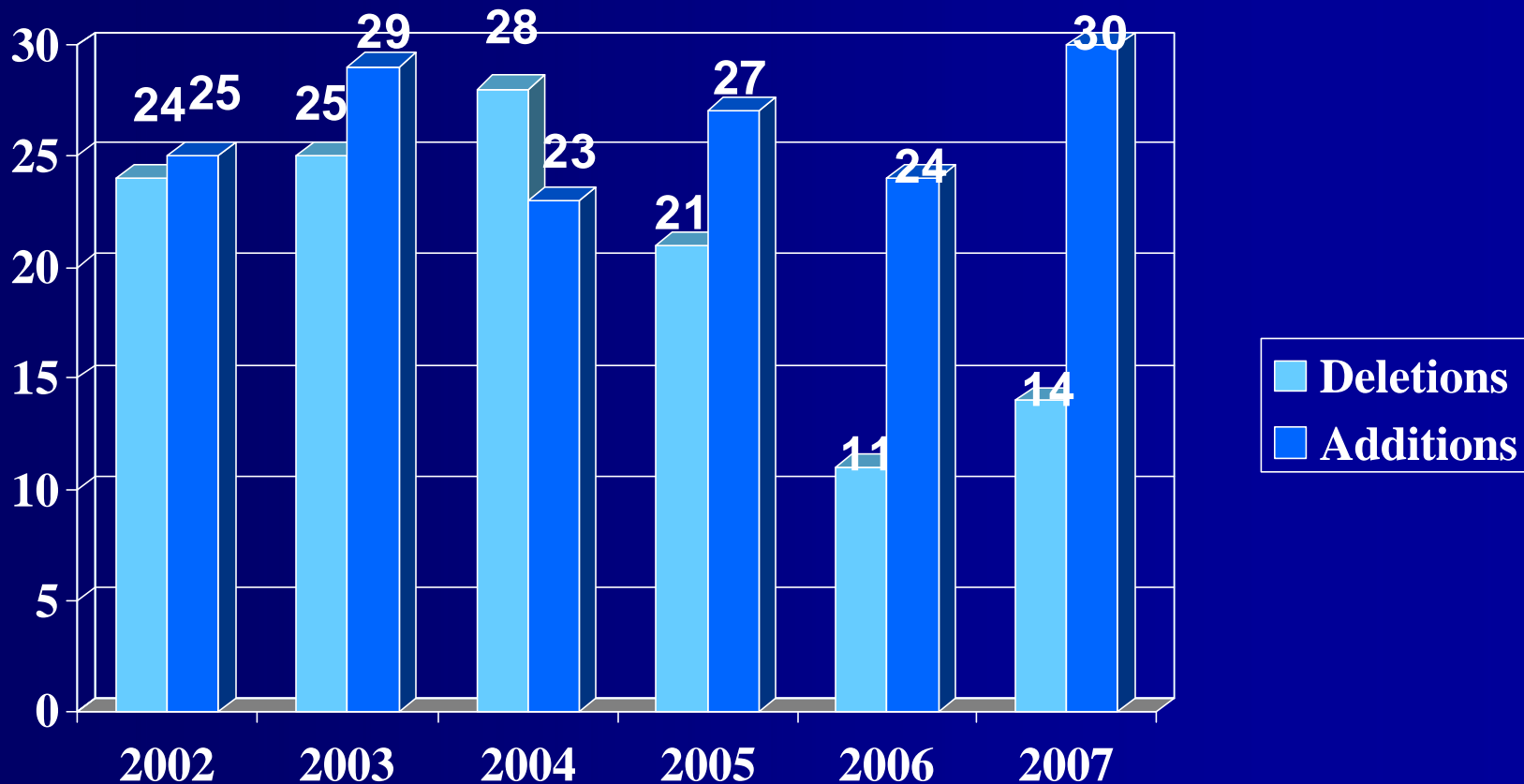

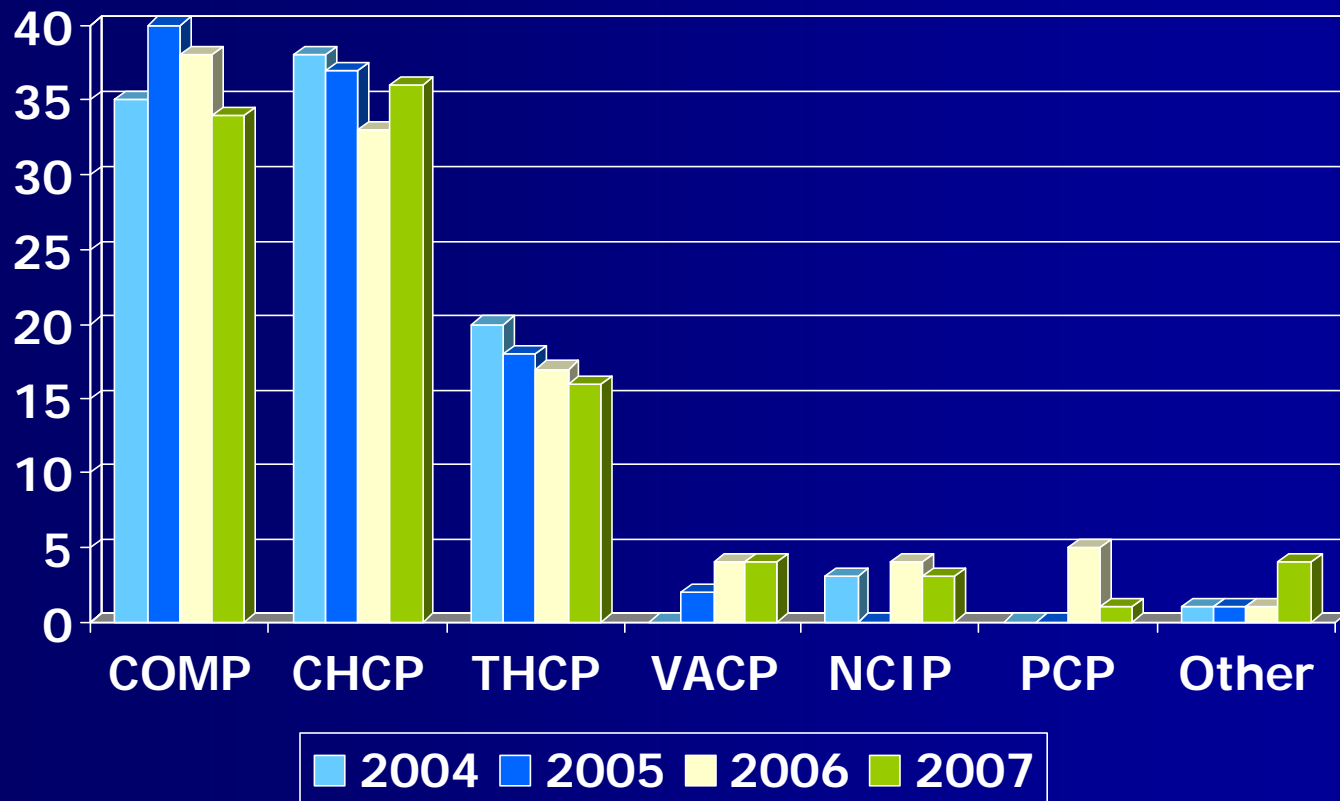
Percentage Distribution of Cancer Programs by Category



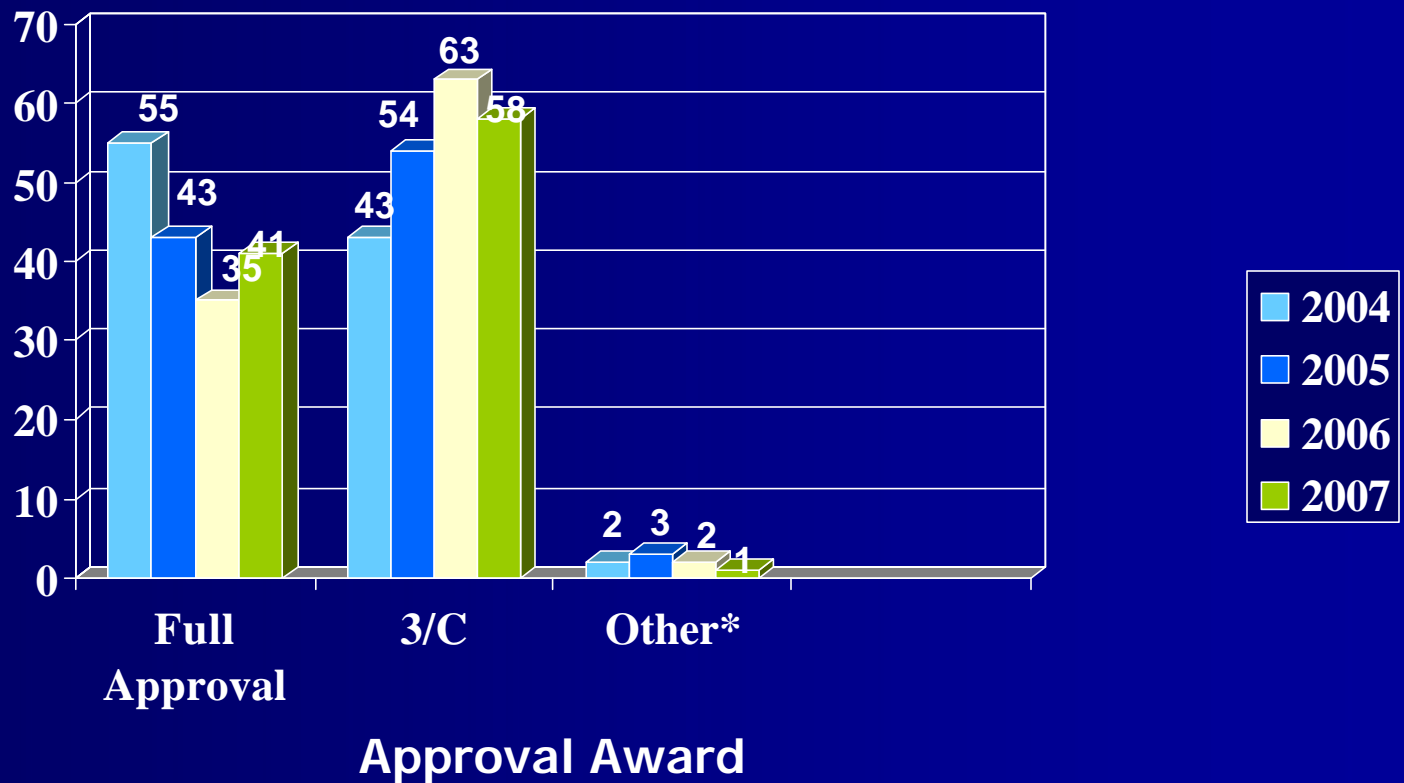
Annual Changes in Approved Programs



Percentage Comparison of Surveys by Category, 2004 - 2007



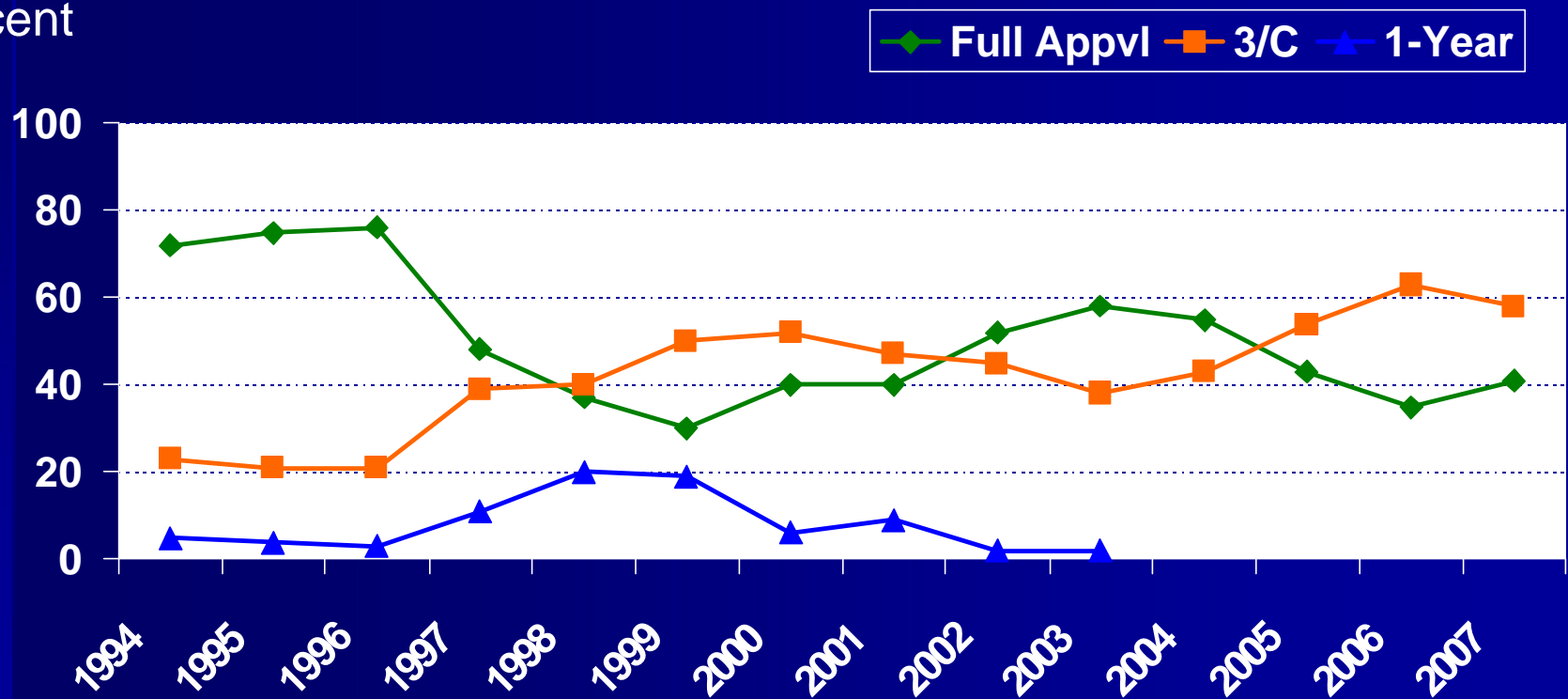
Percentage Distribution of Approval Awards Following Survey, 2004 - 2007



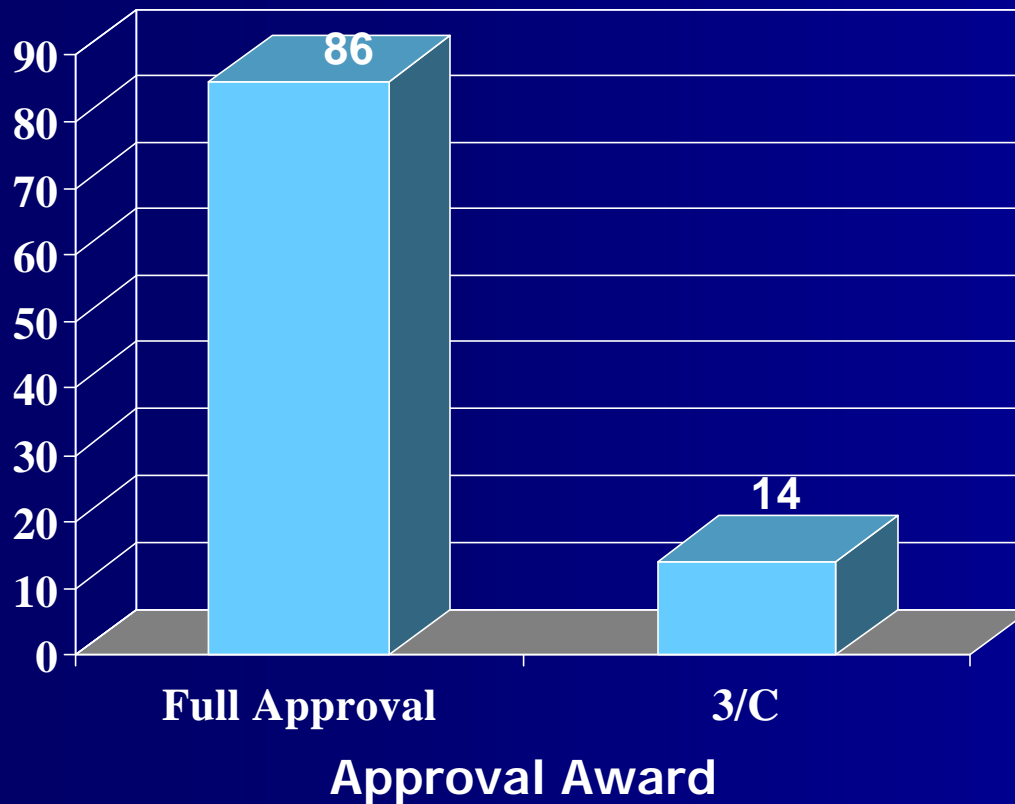

Annual Distribution of Approval Awards Following Survey, 1994 - 2007

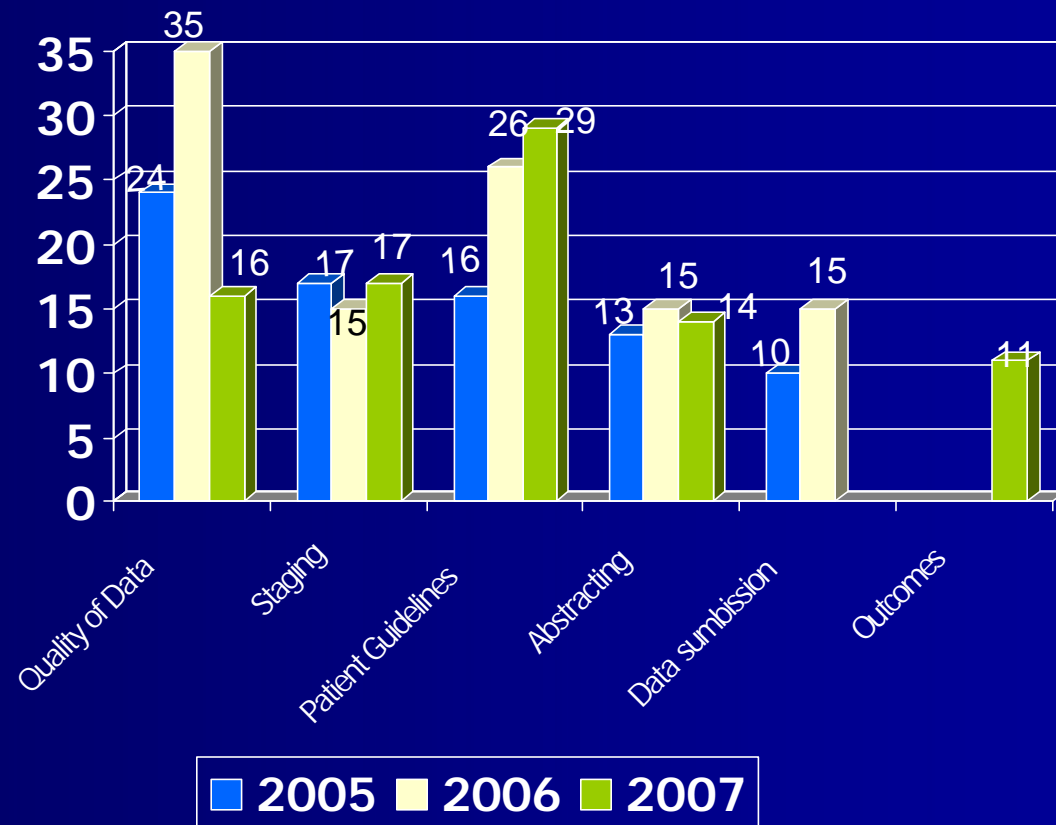

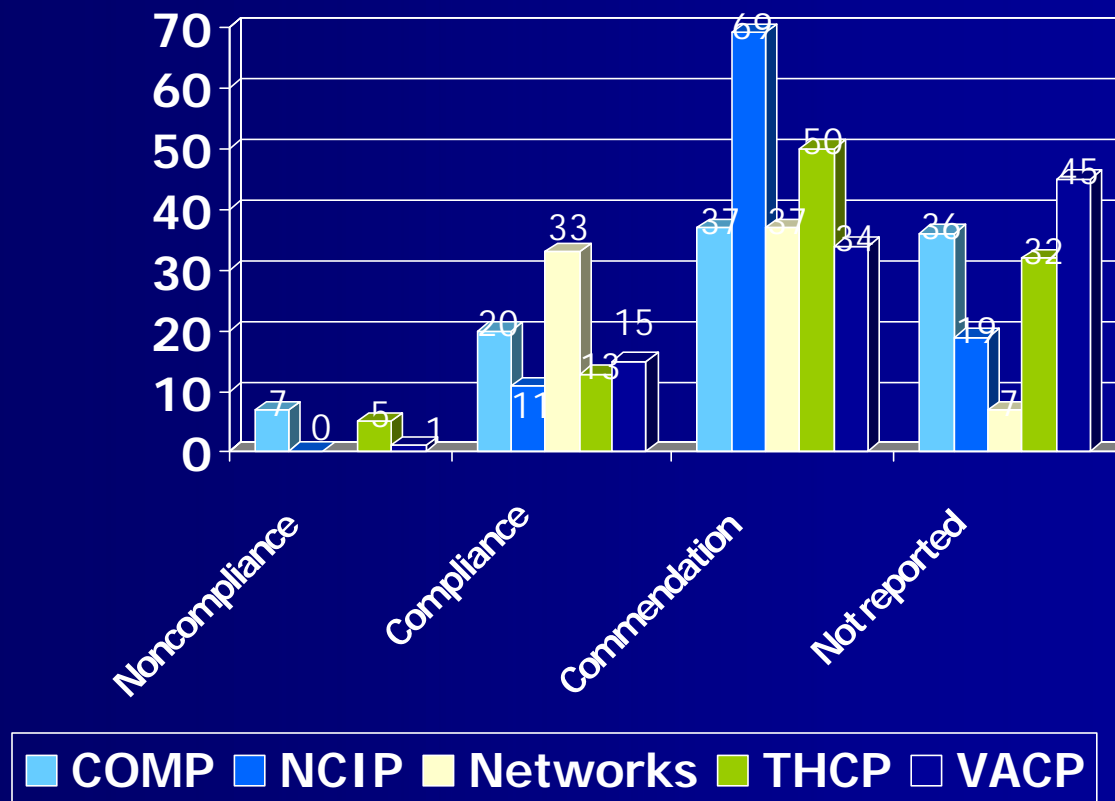
