### **GROUND TRANSPORTATION**

**Public Trans:** Take Light Rail from Baltimore/Washington International Airport (BWI) to Penn Station and then take taxi (\$15-20) to hotel (<http://www.mtmaryland.com/services/lightrail/>).

**By Taxi:** Taxi service is available from Baltimore/Washington International Airport (BWI) to the hotel for approximately \$40 one way.

**By Car:** From Baltimore/Washington International Airport (BWI):  
Take Baltimore Washington Parkway North. Baltimore Washington Parkway turns into Russell Street. Follow Russell Street 8 miles to Pratt Street and turn Right. Proceed on Pratt Street through 10 lights to Presidents Street. Take a Right on President Street and proceed through three lights getting into the right hand lane after the second light (Eastern Avenue). Go straight at the third light towards the Katyn Memorial. Enter the traffic circle and follow to the first right (approximately 50 feet) onto Aliceanna Street. Hotel entrance is approximately 100 yards on the Right. To park make a right before Hotel Entrance and PMI Garage is on the right hand side. Garage entrance leads into the hotel's 3<sup>rd</sup> floor

Self Parking is available at the hotel for \$21.00 per day and Valet parking is available at the hotel for \$32 per day.

### **CLIMATE/ATTIRE**

Average summer temperatures for the Baltimore area range from 80-90 F degrees. Please also remember that the temperature in hotel ballrooms is frequently unpredictable, so it is best to bring along a jacket or sweater that can be added or removed throughout the sessions.
