

2005 CINJ at Cooper PI Report to Cooper PI Committee

- As of December 31 2005, the CINJ at Cooper PI Committee completed its 3rd full calendar year of monitoring indicators and reporting on the Oncology Program
- CINJ at Cooper is currently monitoring 20 indicators in 9 separate areas (Nurse Coordinators, outpatient Social Work, Radiation Oncology, outpatient Dietitian, Hematology Oncology, 9th floor inpatient nursing unit, Camden infusion unit, Gynecology Oncology, and Cancer Registry)
- Over the past 12 months there were 4 indicators, in 4 separate areas, that *reached maximum improvement*, were discontinued, and replaced with new indicators
- Hem/Onc – (List: previous and new indicators)
- Gyn/Onc -- (List: previous and new indicators)
- RN Coordinators – (List: previous and new indicators)
- 9th floor inpatient nursing unit – (List: previous and new indicators)
- Areas that showed the *most significant improvement* are:
 - Hem/Onc – (Indicator listed)
 - Ca Regis – (Indicator listed)
- All existing members of the committee now have a good working knowledge of how their individual departments and indicators relate to the overall improvement of the Oncology Program (**2005 goal**)
- With the growth of the Oncology Program, comes growth to the PI Committee
 - (___) was added to the committee in 2005, to provide physician involvement; her valuable perspective is a welcome addition (**2005 goal**)
