Current Issues Early 2008 surveillance CT – development of a 1.1 cm nodule in rt post costophrenic sulcus. Follow-up PET scan in May showed progression of the nodule.

Social History Retired aerospace engineer moved to Prescott to take up gunsmithing. Smoked one pack per day for 50 yrs, quit 2004. Alcohol is occasional.

NOTES 2000: Prostate cancer, early. s/p prostatectomy
Low grade malignancy of the lt ureter requiring stents for obstruction
On 5L of O2
7/17/08 Repeat scan in several months, put on antibiotics and see if scan changes. If tumor increases in size, biopsy and place fiducials –then cyberknife
