Instructions to view Webinars

Please note: All users must register under their own personal account, otherwise participation certificates will not be registered to the appropriate person.

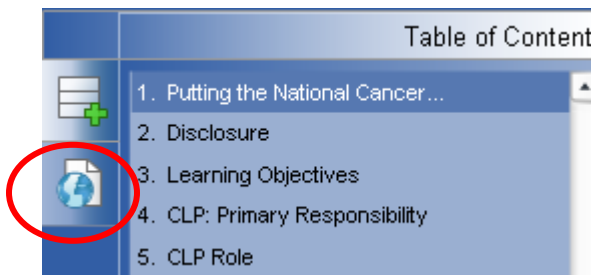
1. Create a personal account with a unique login name and password to register and view these webinars.
 - To create an account, click on the link to the left for “Log in/Create an Account”. On the following pages, you will need to provide all the data requested under “Create an Account” and input all the information requested for your profile.
 - The next time you visit this site, you will be prompted to enter your username and password. After entering this information, you can click on the CLP Education tab on the left side of the page which will take you to the list of the five webinars for selection.

2. To select a webinar, click on the blue tab “Cancer Liaison Physician Edu” to the left. You will see a list of the available CLP webinars.
3. To select the webinar you wish to view, click on the blue “More Info and Order Now” button below the webinar description.
4. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click on “Add to Cart”. You will be directed to the “Carts Content” page.
5. Click on “Checkout”. You will be directed to the “Check out” page.
6. Click on the blue “Submit Registration” button at the bottom of the page. You will be directed to the “Registration Complete” page. Viewing instructions will be at the bottom of this page. A confirmation email with the same information will also be sent to you.
