Rules for Extensions:

Extensions for Standard 5.5 (timeliness) are granted under highly unusual circumstances only. Extensions must be requested on or prior to the January 31 submission deadline. Direct your written request (e-mail is fine) with an explanation of the problem and when you expect to be able to submit to Jerri Linn Phillips (jphillips@facs.org). You will be informed by e-mail whether you received the extension and when the extended deadline will be. Most extensions are for 2 weeks only.

Extensions for Standard 5.5 will affect the program's rating on Standard 5.6. If an extension for Standard 5.5 is granted and the data are submitted after January 31, that submission will not qualify for possible Standard 5.6 commendation even if the data are clean when they are submitted. (Translation: there is a disadvantage to delaying initial submission in order to assure all data are clean at initial submission; submit on time, then clean cases diagnosed in 2003 or later by the April 1 correction deadline for compliance with both standards).

No extensions are given for Standard 5.6.
