

**Checklist for Role-modeling Behaviors Associated with PATIENT CARE**

Do I? . . .	
Y N NA	<p align="center"><b>Pre-Rotation</b></p> <p>Clarify expectations to the students as well as their role on the team on the first or second day of the rotation?</p>
Y N NA	Make students feel like part of the team?
Y N NA	Assign specific patients to students with responsibilities?
Y N NA	<p align="center"><b>Rounds</b></p> <p>Have students present patients with independently derived assessments and plans?</p>

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<b>Wards</b>
Allow the students to write notes and orders independently before reviewing them?

<b>Call/Consults/Clinics</b>
Supervise the students' history-taking and physical exam skills and provide constructive feedback?
Review the patients' differential diagnoses with the students?
Make the students uncomfortable by giving feedback in front of the patients?
<b>Bedside Procedures</b>
Discuss the procedure, indications, and possible complications beforehand with the student?
Supervise the student during the procedure and offer feedback after completion?
<b>Overall</b>
Discuss with the student his/her progress in a timely manner that allows the student the opportunity to improve during the rotation?
