

Germany Traveling Fellow selected for 2010

Gregory J. Landry, MD, FACS, associate professor of surgery, Oregon Health & Science University, Portland, has been selected as the 2010 ACS Traveling Fellow to Germany.

As the Germany Traveling Fellow, Dr. Landry—a vascular surgeon—will participate in the annual meeting of the German Surgical Society in Berlin, Germany, April 20–23, 2010. He will attend and participate in the ACS Germany Chapter meeting during that event. Dr. Landry will also travel to several surgical centers in Germany,
