

Presidential Addresses available on archives site

The History and Archives page of the ACS Web site now has links to PDF files of all existing Presidential Addresses from the annual Clinical Congress. The files, which can be accessed and downloaded from the site at <http://www.facs.org/archives>, include the Presidential Address of J.M.T. Finney, MD, FACS, from 1913, and continue to the 2009 presentation by LaMar S. McGinnis, Jr., MD, FACS.

The Digital Collections highlight four categories of historic re-

ords from the College's archives:

- The *Clinical Congress Daily News*, 1911–1979
- Board of Regents photos, 1920–2006
- The 1927 volume of the *Franklin Martin Memoirs*, a set of binders prepared by Franklin H. Martin, MD, FACS, and his wife, Isabelle, that documents the history of the College. Dr. Martin founded the ACS and served as managing editor (1905–1935) of the College's scientific journal, *Surgery, Gy-*

necology and Obstetrics, which is today called the *Journal of the American College of Surgeons*.

- Volume 4 of a 26-volume set of the Eleanor Grimm Notebooks, a rich resource of ACS history, compiled by Ms. Grimm, who served as Dr. Martin's secretary from the College's founding in 1913 until his death in 1935.
