Abstracts MAY NOT have been presented and/or published (in whole or in part) prior to their presentation at the 2007 Spring Meeting of the American College of Surgeons.

Categories suitable for abstract submission are as follows:

- Alimentary Tract (including liver, pancreas, biliary tract)
- Critical Care (including metabolism, infection, nutrition, blood, endocrine)
- General Surgery
- Surgical Oncology and Associated Immunology
- Trauma
- Vascular Surgery
- Education and Training
- Other

The maximum word count is 250.
