Surgical Residents Submit Your Cases

The Spring Meeting in Las Vegas, Nevada will feature “Spectacular Cases From Residents.” This program will take place on Monday, April 23, 2007 from 9:30 – 11:00 am and will involve five residents chosen to present extraordinary cases that they have encountered. Residents will present their cases to an expert panel, followed by a discussion led by A. Frederick Schild, MD, FACS, and Juan Carlos Paramo, MD, FACS. Each resident will have approximately 10 minutes to present the case, after which 5 minutes will be allocated for discussion. A total of five cases will be presented.

Submission Method and Deadline:

We invite surgical residents to submit a case worthy of discussion. Please e-mail a one-page, double-spaced, abstract as a Word document attachment to spectacularcases@facs.org. Include the title and description of the case, along with your name, mailing address, phone, fax, and e-mail address. The maximum word count is 300.

Abstracts may be submitted until **January 8, 2007 at 5:00 pm (CST)**. Abstracts received after the deadline will not be considered.
