ARIZONA STATE-MANDATED CME CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

CME Requirements At-A-Glance	<p>Renewal cycle: Biennial – Renew every other year before licensee’s DOB</p> <p>Minimum CMEs: 40 CME during each renewal cycle</p> <p>State-mandated CME content</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 CME addressing the effective and safe prescribing of opioids
State-Mandated CME Content Detail	<p>A physician who is authorized to prescribe schedule II controlled substances and holds a valid U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration registration number shall complete at least three hours of opioid-related, substance-use-disorder-related, or addiction-related continuing medical education during each renewal cycle.</p>
