ARKANSAS STATE-MANDATED CME CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

<p>CME Requirements At-A-Glance</p>	<p>Renewal cycle: Annual – Licenses expire last day of the month of licensee’s DOB</p> <p>Minimum CMEs: 20 CME annually</p> <p>State-mandated CME content</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 CME regarding the prescribing of opioids and benzodiazepines
<p>State-Mandated CME Content Detail</p>	<p>A minimum of 50% of CME hours must be Category 1 and in the physician's primary area of practice.</p> <p>Each physician shall obtain at least one (1) hour of CME credit specifically regarding the prescribing of opioids and benzodiazepines. The one hour may be included in the twenty (20) credit hours of required continuing medical education required annually.</p>
