

## CONNECTICUT STATE-MANDATED CME CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

<p><b>CME Requirements At-A-Glance</b></p>	<p><b>Renewal cycle:</b> <a href="#">Annual - Register during licensee's month of birth</a></p> <p><b>Minimum CMEs:</b> <a href="#">50 CME in the area of physician's practice during the 24 months preceding renewal</a></p> <p><b>State-mandated CME content</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">1 CME in Infectious Diseases, Risk Management, Sexual Assault, Domestic Violence, Cultural Competency, and Behavioral Health during the first renewal period and then not less than once every six years</a></li> </ul>
<p><b>State-Mandated CME Content Detail</b></p>	<p>During the first renewal period in which continuing medical education is required and not less than once every six years thereafter, CME must include at least one contact hour in each of the following topics: (A) Infectious diseases, including, but not limited to, acquired immune deficiency syndrome and human immunodeficiency virus, (B) risk management, including, but not limited to, prescribing controlled substances and pain management, (C) sexual assault, (D) domestic violence, (E) cultural competency, and (F) behavioral health, such behavioral health continuing medical education may include, but not be limited to, diagnosing and treating (i) cognitive conditions, including, but not limited to, Alzheimer's disease, dementia, delirium, related cognitive impairments and geriatric depression, or at least two contact hours on the topic of mental health conditions common to veterans and family members of veterans, including (i) determining whether a patient is a veteran or family member of a veteran, (ii) screening for conditions such as post-traumatic stress disorder, risk of suicide, depression and grief, and (iii) suicide prevention training.</p>
