CME Requirements At-A-Glance	<p>Renewal cycle: Biennial – Licenses expire March 31 of odd-numbered years</p> <p>Minimum CMEs: 40 Category 1 CME</p> <p>State-mandated CME content</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 CME on Child Abuse and Domestic Violence
State-Mandated CME Content Detail	One-hour training meeting the Child Protection Accountability Commission requirements each two-year renewal cycle. To satisfy the mandatory training requirement, the board-approved training must address how to recognize child abuse and domestic violence and provide Delaware-specific information on reporting child abuse.
Accepted CME	Category I courses approved by the American Medical Association (AMA) or equivalent courses approved by the American Osteopathic Association (AOA)
Notes	If you hold a controlled substance registration, you must file a separate renewal application. See Controlled Substances Registration Renewal .
