<p>State-Mandated CME Content Detail</p>	<p>One (1) live hour Florida Laws and Rules & Professional and Medical Ethics; 2 Prescribing Controlled Substances (new opioid course); 2 live Prevention of Medical Errors.</p> <p>Twenty (20) continuing medical education hours must be AOA Category 1-A hours.</p> <p>*One (1) CME addressing HIV/AIDS for first-time renewals whose license was issued <i>prior</i> to July 1 of the second year of the biennium.</p>
