CME Requirements At-A-Glance	<p>Renewal cycle: Biennial</p> <p>Minimum CMEs: 40 CME every two-year renewal cycle*</p> <p>State-mandated CME content</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 Medical Error every biennial renewal cycle (re five most mis-diagnosed medical conditions in Florida) • 2 Controlled Substance Prescribing every renewal cycle • 2 Domestic Violence every third biennial renewal cycle • One-Time Requirement: 1 Human Trafficking
State-Mandated CME Content Detail	<p>Prevention of Medical Errors course must contain the five most mis-diagnosed medical conditions in Florida for the previous two years. All physicians registered with the DEA must complete a Controlled Substance Prescribing course by January 31, 2019 and each subsequent renewal.</p> <p>Each licensee shall complete a board-approved 1 hour course on human trafficking by January 1, 2021.</p>

Notes	*INITIAL RENEWAL: If you are renewing your license for the first time, you are exempt from the general CME requirement, but you are required to complete 2 hours of Preventing Medical Errors and 1 hour addressing HIV/AIDS.
