CME Requirements At-A-Glance	<p>Renewal cycle: Biennial - Based on DOB</p> <p>Minimum CMEs: 40 CME every two-year renewal period</p> <p>State-mandated CME content:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 CDC Prescribing Guidelines • *2 Child Abuse and/or 2 Dependent Adult Abuse for relevant specialties
State-Mandated CME Content Detail	<p>Physicians, ARNPS, PAs, Dentists, and Podiatrists Who Prescribe Opioids Must Receive Continuing Education on CDC Opioid Prescribing Guidelines.</p> <p>*A licensee who regularly provides primary health care to children must complete two (2) hours of child abuse identification and reporting every five years. A licensee who regularly provides primary health care to adults must complete two (2) hours in dependent-adult abuse identification and reporting every five years. (Or a combined two (2) hour course on Mandatory Reporter Training - Child and Dependent adult abuse)</p>
