MAINE STATE-MANDATED CME CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

CME Requirements At-A-Glance	<p>Renewal cycle: Biennial – Licenses expire based on DOB</p> <p>Minimum CMEs: 40 Category 1 CME every two-year renewal cycle</p> <p>State-mandated CME content</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 Opioid Prescribing every two years
State-Mandated CME Content Detail	<p>All licensees need to complete 3 hours of AMA category 1 CME on opioid prescribing every 2 years.</p> <p>Buprenorphine Waiver Training as described by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMSHA) may be counted toward meeting the requirement of this law as long as the training is approved Category 1 Continuing Medical Education by the American Medical Association Council on Medical Education (AMA).</p> <p>Three hours of any Category 1 AMA approved program on the prescribing of opioids will suffice. The CME must be taken since your last renewal in order to be counted towards this requirement.</p>
