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| CME Requirements At-A-Glance | <p>Renewal cycle: Three Years</p> <p>Minimum CMEs: 150 CME every three years, minimum of 75 Category 1</p> <p>State-mandated CME content</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Every Three Years: 3 Pain Management, and 1 Ethics • One-Time Requirement: Identifying Human Trafficking |
| State-Mandated CME Content Detail | <p>A minimum of 1 hour of continuing education must be earned in the area of medical ethics. Effective December 6, 2017 a minimum of 3 hours of continuing education must be earned in the area of pain and symptom management.</p> <p>Proof of completion of training to identify victims of human trafficking. This is a one-time training that is separate from continuing education (CE). Licensees renewing in 2017 must complete training by renewal in 2020; renewals for 2018 by 2021, and renewals for 2019 by 2022. Beginning December 6, 2021, completion of the training is a requirement for initial license issuance.</p> |
