CME Requirements At-A-Glance	<p>Renewal cycle: Annual License Renewal</p> <p>Minimum CMEs: 35 CME Annually – Minimum of 10 Category 1</p> <p>State-mandated CME content</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Annually: 2 Substance Abuse, Prescribing of Opioids, or Addiction • Even-numbered Years Only: 2 Ethics, Pain Management, or Addiction Care • Every Four Years: 2 Suicide Prevention
State-Mandated CME Content Detail	<p>EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2018: REQUIRED ANNUALLY- Two (2) hours of CMEs in substance abuse of controlled substances, the prescribing of opioids or addiction.</p> <p>EVEN YEARS ONLY: Two (2) credits in ethics, pain management or addiction care.</p> <p>EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2017 - NEW SUICIDE PREVENTION REQUIREMENT: Two (2) hours on evidence-based suicide prevention and awareness within TWO years of licensure; THEN two (2) hours completed every FOUR (4) years thereafter.</p>
