NEVADA STATE-MANDATED CME CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

CME Requirements At-A-Glance	<p>Renewal cycle: Biennial renewal by July 1 of odd-numbered years</p> <p>Minimum CMEs: 40 CME every two-year renewal cycle</p> <p>State-mandated CME content</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 20 Within the scope of licensee’s surgical specialty • 2 Ethics • 2 Misuse/Abuse of Controlled Substances/Prescribing/Addiction • *2 Suicide Detection/Intervention/Prevention (every four years)
State-Mandated CME Content Detail	<p>Minim of forty (40) hours of AMA Category 1 continuing medical education (CME), two (2) hours of which must be in medical ethics, pain management and/or addiction care, and twenty (20) hours of within the scope of practice or specialty. (At least 2 hours every 4 years must be on suicide detection, intervention and prevention.)</p>
