CME Requirements At-A-Glance	Renewal cycle: Biennial Minimum CMEs: 100 CME every two-year renewal cycle State-mandated CME content <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 Opioid Prescribing
State-Mandated CME Content Detail	<p>All prescribers required to register with the program who possess a U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) license number shall complete 3 contact hours or Category 1 CME in the area of pain management and addiction disorder or a combination, as a condition for license renewal. The course abstract and learning objectives must reference opioid prescribing for the management or treatment of pain, or for the treatment of opioid use disorders.</p>
