<b>CME Requirements At-A-Glance</b>	<p><b>Renewal cycle:</b> <a href="#">Annual renewal on or before June 30</a></p> <p><b>Minimum CMEs:</b> <a href="#">16 AOA Category 1 CME every year</a></p> <p><b>State-mandated CME content</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">1 Proper Prescribing every other year</a></li> </ul>
<b>State-Mandated CME Content Detail</b>	<p>One hour every other year shall be devoted to the subject of the proper prescribing, dispensing, and administering of Controlled Dangerous Substances. This one (1) hour program of CME shall be obtained at a seminar approved by the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners.</p>
