<p>CME Requirements At-A-Glance</p>	<p>Renewal cycle: Biennial – On or before December 31 of odd-numbered years</p> <p>Minimum CMEs: 60 CME every TWO years</p> <p>State-mandated CME content</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One-Time Requirement: 7 Pain Management or the Treatment of the Terminally Ill
<p>State-Mandated CME Content Detail</p>	<p>One-time requirement within the first year of licensure of completion of a one-hour course provided by the Oregon Pain Management Commission of the Department of Human Services.</p> <p>Six additional CME in the area of pain management or the treatment of terminally ill and dying patients.</p>
