STATE-MANDATED CME CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

CME Requirements At-A-Glance	<p>Renewal cycle: Biennial – Renew by October 31 of even-numbered years</p> <p>Minimum CMEs: 100 CME every two years – Minimum of 20 Category 1</p> <p>State-mandated CME content</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 Pain Management/Addiction/Prescribing of Opioids • 2 Child Abuse
State-Mandated CME Content Detail	<p>Licenseses must complete at least two (2) hours of continuing education each renewal period in pain management, the identification of addiction, or the practices of prescribing or dispensing of opioids.</p> <p>As a condition of biennial renewal, you are required to complete 2 hours of approved training on the topic of child abuse recognition and reporting from an approved provider.</p>
