PENNSYLVANIA STATE-MANDATED CME CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

CME Requirements At-A-Glance	<p>Renewal cycle: Biennial - Renew by December 31 of even-numbered years</p> <p>Minimum CMEs: 100 CME every two years – Minimum of 20 Category 1</p> <p>State-mandated CME content</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 Board-Approved Child Abuse Recognition/Reporting • 2 Pain Management/Addiction/Prescribing • 12 Patient Safety/Risk Management
State-Mandated CME Content Detail	<p>Two (2) hours of Board-approved continuing education in child abuse recognition and reporting requirements must be completed for renewal or reactivation of a license.</p> <p>All prescribers or dispensers must complete at least two hours of continuing education in pain management, the identification of addiction or in the practices of prescribing or dispensing of opioids.</p> <p>At least 12 of the 100 hours must be completed in activities related to patient safety or risk management and may be completed in either Category 1 or 2.</p>
