## RHODE ISLAND STATE-MANDATED CME CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

<b>CME Requirements At-A-Glance</b>	<p><b>Renewal cycle:</b> <a href="#">Biennial registration by June 1 of even-numbered years</a></p> <p><b>Minimum CMEs:</b> <a href="#">40 Category 1 CME every two-year renewal cycle</a></p> <p><b>State-mandated CME content</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">4 CME on current topics of concern: Ethics, Risk Management, Opioid Pain Management/Chronic Pain Management, End of Life/Palliative Care, and/or Antimicrobial Stewardship</a></li> </ul>
<b>State-Mandated CME Content Detail</b>	<p>At least 4 hours of continuing medical education shall be earned on topics of current concern as determined by the director of the Rhode Island Department of Health. Current topics include: Ethics, Risk Management, Opioid pain management / chronic pain management, End of life / palliative care, Antimicrobial Stewardship.</p>
