CME Requirements At-A-Glance	<p>Renewal cycle: Biennial – Renew by June 30 of odd-numbered years</p> <p>Minimum CMEs: 40 Category 1 CME every two years – 30 of which are specialty related</p> <p>State-mandated CME content</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 Prescribing and Monitoring Controlled Substances
State-Mandated CME Content Detail	Two of the 40 CME must be address appropriate procedures for prescribing and monitoring controlled substances. These two hours are required every two years regardless of specialty or whether you actually prescribe controlled substances.
