CME Requirements At-A-Glance	<p>Renewal cycle: Biennial - based on licensee's DOB</p> <p>Minimum CMEs: 40 CME each two-year renewal cycle</p> <p>State-mandated CME content</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 Controlled Substance Prescribing
State-Mandated CME Content Detail	Two (2) controlled substance prescribing, which must include instruction in the Department’s Chronic Pain Guidelines on opioids, benzodiazepines, barbiturates and carisoprodol and may include topics such as medicine addiction, risk management tools and other topics approved by the Board.
