## TEXAS STATE-MANDATED CME CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

<b>CME Requirements At-A-Glance</b>	<p><b>Renewal cycle:</b> <a href="#">Biennial</a></p> <p><b>Minimum CMEs:</b> <a href="#">48 CME every two-year renewal cycle – minimum of 24 Category 1 or 1A</a></p> <p><b>State-mandated CME content</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">2 Medical Ethics/Professional Responsibility</a></li> </ul>
<b>State-Mandated CME Content Detail</b>	At least two formal hours must involve the study of Medical Ethics and/or Professional Responsibility (including, but not limited to: Risk Management, Domestic Abuse, or Child Abuse). Formal courses must be approved for Ethics or Professional Responsibility by the accrediting agency.
