<p>CME Requirements At-A-Glance</p>	<p>Renewal cycle: Biennial renewal by January 31 of even-numbered years</p> <p>Minimum CMEs: 40 CME every two-year renewal cycle – Minimum of 34 Category 1</p> <p>State-mandated CME content</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3.5 Controlled Substance Prescribing
<p>State-Mandated CME Content Detail</p>	<p>The 3.5 hours of the controlled substance prescribing classes under Subsection shall include educational content covering the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scope of the controlled substance abuse problem in Utah and the nation • All elements of the FDA Blueprint for Prescriber Education • National and Utah-specific resources available to prescribers • Patient record documentation for controlled substance and opioid prescribing • Office policies, procedures, ad implementation <p>An M.D. or D.O. shall complete these hours in classes that qualify for the American Medical Association Physician's Recognition Award Category 1 Credit.</p>
