## VIRGINIA STATE-MANDATED CME CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

<b>CME Requirements At-A-Glance</b>	<p><b>Renewal cycle:</b> <a href="#">Biennial based on DOB</a></p> <p><b>Minimum CMEs:</b> <a href="#">60 CME every two-year renewal cycle – Minimum of 30 Category 1</a></p> <p><b>State-mandated CME content</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">2 Controlled Substances</a></li> </ul>
<b>State-Mandated CME Content Detail</b>	<p>Every 2 years, licensees with prescriptive authority must complete 2 hours of continuing education (CE) in pain management, proper prescribing of controlled substances, and the diagnosis and management of addiction. For the upcoming biennium, the Board has developed a package of activities that will satisfy the requirement for 2 hours of Type 1 CE for renewal in 2019-2020. <a href="#">Here is the link to the package.</a></p> <p>Licensees who do not wish to use the Board's 2-hour package for their opioid CE are responsible for finding Type 1 activities that relate to pain management, proper prescribing of controlled substances, and the diagnosis and management of addiction.</p>
