<b>CME Requirements At-A-Glance</b>	<p><b>Renewal cycle:</b> <a href="#">Biennial renewal based on DOB</a></p> <p><b>Minimum CMEs:</b> <a href="#">200 CME every FOUR years</a></p> <p><b>State-mandated CME content</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">One-time requirement: 6 Suicide Assessment, Treatment, and Management</a></li> </ul>
<b>State-Mandated CME Content Detail</b>	<p>One-time training requirement of six-hour suicide assessment, treatment and management to be completed during the first full continuing education reporting period after January 1, 2016 or during the first full continuing education period after initial licensure, whichever occurs later.</p>
