### STATE-MANDATED CME CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

<b>CME Requirements At-A-Glance</b>	<p><b>Renewal cycle:</b> <a href="#">Biennial</a></p> <p><b>Minimum CMEs:</b> <a href="#">32 CME each two-year renewal cycle – Minimum of 16 AOA Category 1A or 1B</a></p> <p><b>State-mandated CME content</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">3 Prescribing Practices</a></li> </ul>
<b>State-Mandated CME Content Detail</b>	<p>A three-hour CME, course which has been approved by the WV Board of Osteopathic Medicine, must be completed by any licensee of the Board who prescribes, administers or dispenses a controlled substance. This will be <b>required every two year licensing period</b>, unless the licensee signs a board waiver indicating she/he has not administered, prescribed, or dispensed a controlled substance during the last two year licensing period.</p> <p>CME must receive prior approval from the WV Board of Osteopathic Medicine to be accepted. Check with the CME sponsor before registering to make sure it has been approved by the Board. Board Approved CME Programs can be found on the WVBOM <a href="#">calendar</a>.</p>
