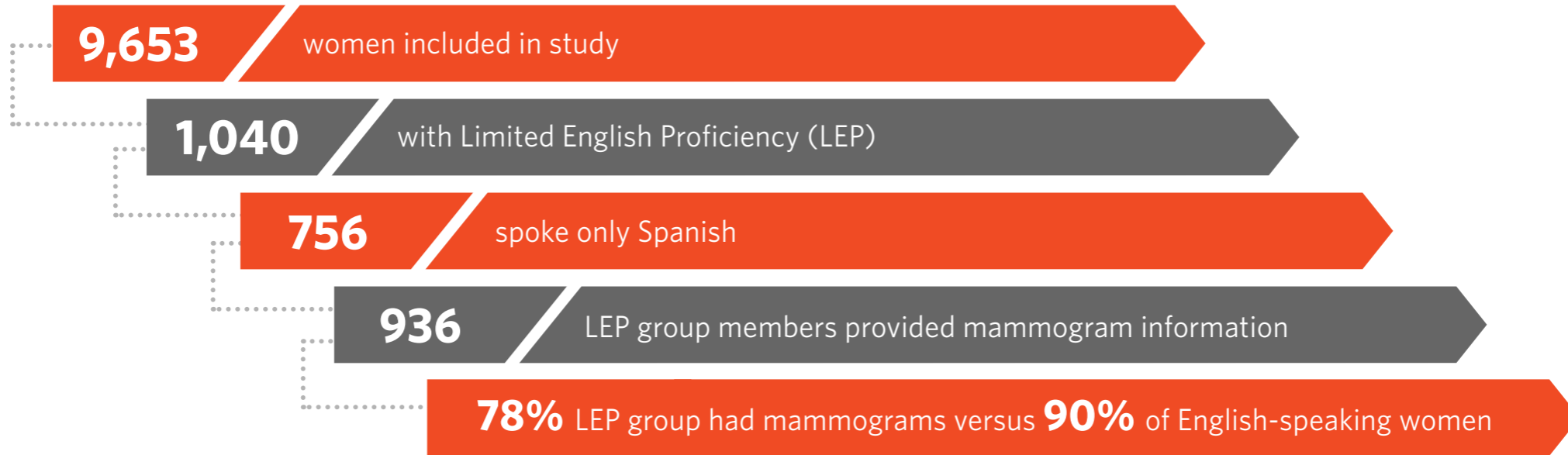


# Women Who Speak Only Spanish Get Mammograms Less Often Than Other Women
