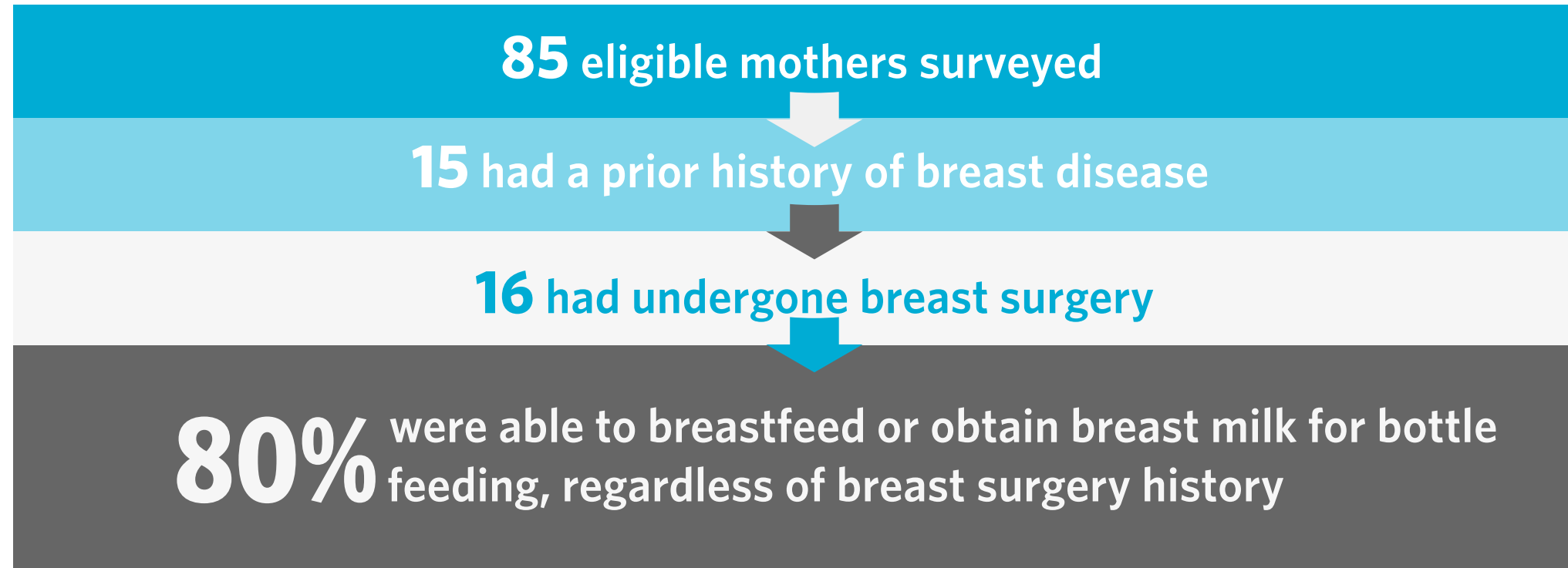


Prior Benign Breast Surgery May Not Impair Future Breastfeeding
