Systems Program Area Overview

The Trauma Systems Program Area's primary focus is the Trauma Systems Consultation (TSC) Program. The TSC program evaluates state/regional trauma systems and provides consultative guidance for future system development. The Trauma Systems Program Area also leads projects, initiatives, and collaborative efforts related to optimizing regional and state trauma systems.

- Collaborate with Systems Program Area Chair and staff to prepare for COT March and October meetings
- Provide strategic leadership and oversight to Systems Program Area workgroups as assigned
- Partner with COT staff for the strategic planning and execution of all approved Systems Program Area related activities

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
