

The NAPBC Announces New Committee Membership and Leadership Opportunities

The NAPBC is seeking nominations for committee leadership positions and new volunteers for committee membership. The deadline for applications is **May 31**; new leadership and membership positions will be announced in the fall.

Committee Membership

New committee members are appointed to a three-year term and are eligible for re-appointment to a second three-year term based on performance, which includes an assessment of meeting attendance and engagement. We encourage applications from women, underrepresented communities, and those of diverse backgrounds. Membership within NAPBC committees will be open to individuals working at NAPBC accredited facilities to fulfill the roles and responsibilities of the committee.
