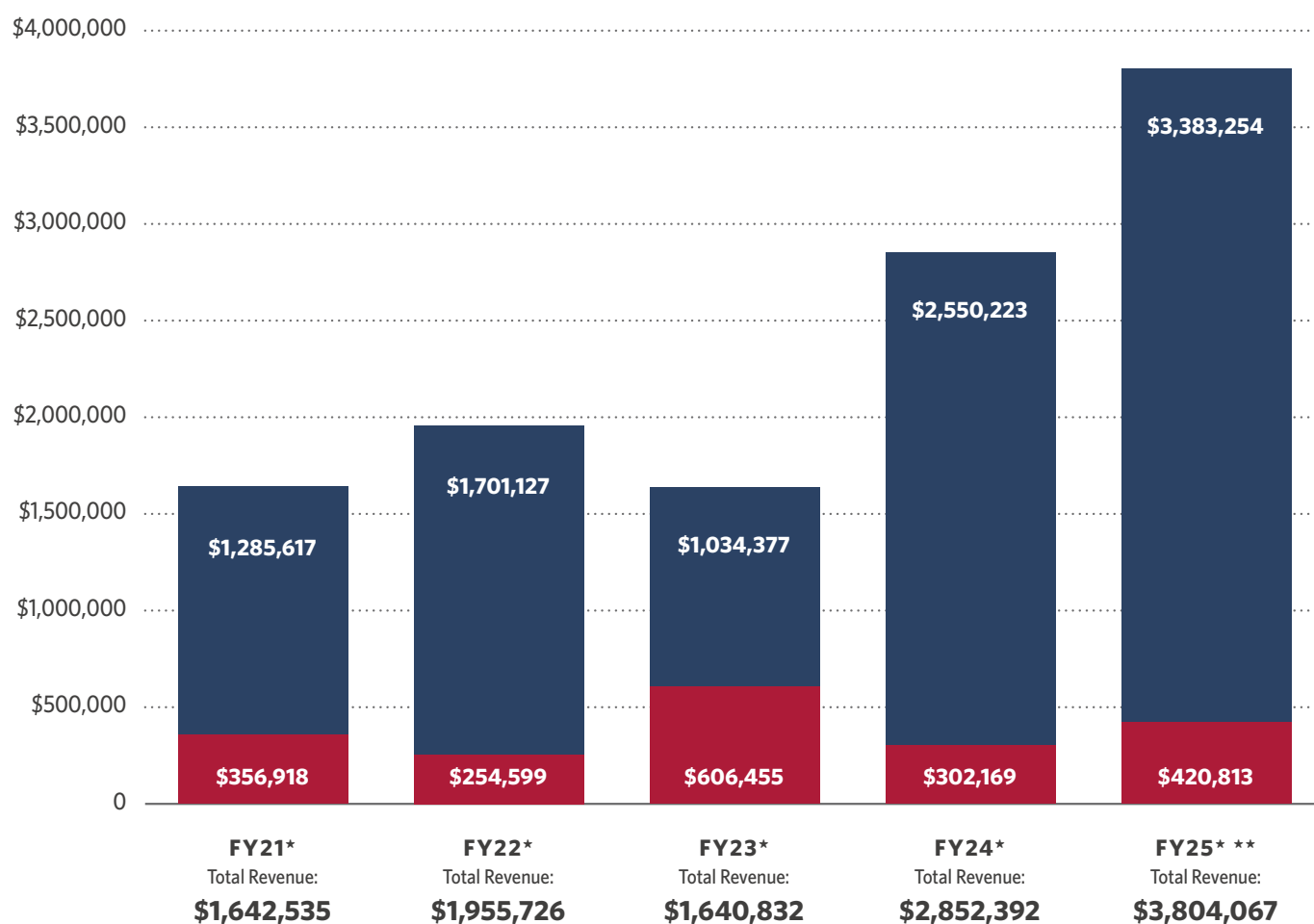

Scholarship Recipients Use ACS Awards to Improve Heart Function, Develop Novel Approaches to Cancer Care

Through generous donations to the ACS Foundation over the past 20 years, the ACS has been able to support numerous surgeons who are making a meaningful difference to the profession and advancing surgical care worldwide. The following highlights two of those individuals—Tammy L. Kindel, MD, PhD, FACS, FASMBS, and Jacqueline S. Jeruss, MD, PhD, FACS.

DR. TAMMY KINDEL



Recipient of the 2020–2025 George H. A. Clowes Jr., MD, FACS, Memorial Research Career Development Award, Dr. Kindel is researching the role of GLP-1s, bariatric surgery, and heart health.

The Clowes Award supported her preliminary research at the Medical College of Wisconsin (MCW) in Milwaukee and led to additional funding from MCW and two awards from the National Institutes of Health (NIH).

“Documenting to the NIH that the American College of Surgeons believed in our research project line and was willing to continue to fund our work provided a strong track record of success and reliability as a principal investigator. Funding has a way to beget more funding,” Dr. Kindel said.

She is working to understand how bariatric surgery improves heart function in patients with obesity-related heart failure so that it will lead to the development of new surgical and nonsurgical therapies for this disease. “We believe that sleeve gastrectomy causes unique changes to both the enterohepatic circulation of bile acids as well as gut microbiome which beneficially helps patients with obesity-associated heart failure,” she said.

A two-time ACS award recipient (2000–2002 Resident Research Scholarship and 2012 ACS Joan L. and Julius H. Jacobson II Promising Investigator Award), Dr. Jeruss continues the meaningful research she began early in her career—developing

novel approaches to cancer care through the study of targeted therapeutic approaches and new treatments that could potentially mitigate off-target effects of therapy to improve quality of life.

Beginning with treatments for aggressive breast cancer subtypes, her translational research efforts expanded to include developing a clinical path for the fertility preservation of young patients with cancer, as well as the management of pregnancy-associated breast cancer.

“Patients would say to me, ‘I’m able to go through treatment with chemotherapy now because I was able to cryopreserve embryos—my future hope is being preserved,’” reflected Dr. Jeruss, the Alfred E. Chang, MD Professor of Surgical Oncology at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor.

She credits her ACS awards for the confidence and optimism it gave her to persevere and generate a “return on the generous investment” that she was granted.

“I remain committed to the meaningfulness of the research that I’ve participated in related to fertility preservation, TGF β signaling and cyclin-dependent kinases inhibition, and cancer progression. The work continues to be challenging, interesting, and inspiring,” she said.

Dr. Raghuvir Gelot Is Honored with 2024 Distinguished Philanthropist Award

The ACS Foundation presented its highest honor, the 2024 Distinguished Philanthropist Award, to Raghuvir Gelot, MD, FACS, during ACS Clinical Congress in San Francisco. This prestigious recognition has been awarded since 1989 to individuals who demonstrate exceptional commitment to advancing surgical practice, research, and patient care.

Recipients of this award, together with other philanthropic supporters, have contributed more than \$25 million to ACS programs, funding scholarships, research awards, and lifelong learning initiatives for surgeons.

“Dr. Gelot’s generosity and commitment to the College inspire others to give, and his philanthropic spirit has left a lasting impact,” said H. Randolph Bailey, MD, FACS, Chair of the ACS Foundation. “We are honored to recognize him as the 2024 Distinguished Philanthropist. His contributions have significantly furthered the College’s goals and initiatives.”

Dr. Gelot, an otolaryngologist and head-and-neck surgeon, served patients throughout his career at East Carolina University Health Roanoke-Chowan Hospital in Ahoskie, North Carolina. A Fellow since 1996, his philanthropy has meaningfully impacted both the surgical community and global healthcare.

His charitable initiatives include establishing the Baxiram S. and Kankuben B. Gelot Community

Surgeons Travel Award in 2008, enabling international physicians to attend ACS Clinical Congress. In 2013, he created the Kankuben B. Gelot Scholarship, supporting nurses and residents attending joint meetings of the North and South Carolina ACS Chapters. He also funds an annual award for resident poster and paper competitions at the event.

Through these scholarships, Dr. Gelot has supported 15 international and 12 domestic scholars in attending Clinical Congress or chapter meetings, while

providing awards to 72 residents participating in clinical competitions.

“I have never thought or dreamed of receiving this prestigious award, and to be named alongside the giants of the American College of Surgeons for someone as obscure as I am is a great honor,” said Dr. Gelot.

“His words are a reflection of his modesty,” said Kenneth W. Sharp, MD, FACS, ACS Regent and Foundation Regental Liaison. “Dr. Gelot is anything but obscure and deserves this recognition.”

The event also featured the Impact Award presentation to Christina Hewes Corson, who established the John Duncan Corson Guest Scholarship in 2021 to honor her husband, John D. Corson, MB ChB, FACS. This award, coordinated by the ACS International Relations Committee, enables early career vascular or cardiothoracic surgeons from the UK and Republic of Ireland to attend Clinical Congress and visit US academic institutions to exchange knowledge on current surgical research.

Transformative Gifts Unlock New Opportunities for Surgery

The largest individual gift in the ACS Foundation's 20-year history—\$2 million—was contributed by Pon Satitpunwaycha, MD, FACS, in March 2025 to support the priorities of the ACS Executive Director and CEO and help advance the College's mission, "To Heal All with Skill and Trust."

"Dr. Pon, as he prefers to be called, is an exemplar, even among philanthropists, for his enormous generosity," said ACS Executive Director and CEO Patricia L. Turner, MD, MBA, FACS, who is also the Foundation President. "His giving is extraordinarily impactful because his lifelong commitment to patients and our commitment to patients are in such close alignment. I am grateful for his engagement with our Foundation over so many years."

Dr. Pon's most-recent gift of \$2 million is one of 17 gifts he has made to the ACS Foundation over the years, with a total of more than \$5.1 million in donations to the College.

"Although he has been incredibly generous to the College, Dr. Pon remains very humble and unassuming about his support," said H. Randolph Bailey, MD, FACS, Chair of the ACS Foundation. "I have asked him about his motivation to support the ACS, and one theme seems to emerge. He feels like surgery and the College have been very good to him and he wants to give back. He says that when we were practicing surgery, we took good care of our patients. Now, we need to take good care of our profession."

After investing in the stock market in 2008, at the suggestion of a patient and having success, Dr. Pon was in a position to make large-scale gifts to the ACS. His generosity has helped fund trauma surgery education, grow international chapters, provide research fellowships and scholarships to burgeoning female surgeons in Africa, and create opportunities for surgeons to better understand and effectively integrate artificial intelligence and machine learning into surgical practice.

“The healthcare situation in the US is very complex, and for a young surgeon, it takes a long time to become established,” said Dr. Pon. “I support the College to ensure that future surgeons have the same opportunities that I had.”

In 2001, Dr. Pon received the Distinguished Philanthropist Award—the Foundation’s highest and most significant honor—for his record of service to the College and the Foundation and his commitment to philanthropy.

Dr. Pon, who was born and raised in Thailand, graduated from Chulalongkorn University in 1962, which is internationally recognized as the top university in Thailand. He completed his internship and residency at Northwestern University in Chicago, Illinois, in 1964, before returning

to Thailand as an instructor at Chulalongkorn University Medical School.

After accepting a fellowship position with the pioneering cardiovascular surgeon Denton A. Cooley, MD, FACS, at The Texas Heart Institute (now part of Baylor College of Medicine) in Houston, Dr. Pon made the decision to remain in the US where he practiced general surgery for more than 40 years.

A fellow of the ACS since 1973, Dr. Pon retired from practice in October 2020, and today, he continues to be a proud member and supporter of the ACS.

“I try to give consistently to the College to support my profession because I always enjoyed being a surgeon,” said Dr. Pon. “I’m just happy to have the opportunity to give back at this point in my life.”
