

# American College of Surgeons Children's Surgery Verification (ACS CSV) Site Visit Agenda

The American College of Surgeons (ACS) verification review process is to verify a hospital's compliance with ACS standards for a children's surgery center. Site Reviewers are charged with the responsibility of obtaining a detailed and accurate assessment of a hospital's capabilities in a very short period of time. For this reason, we ask that the children's surgery program personnel at the hospital carefully prepare for the site visit by having all documents and medical records organized and accessible to the Reviewers. Reviewers will need to have a hospital staff member readily available for questions and requests for additional information throughout the site visit. Please be aware that Reviewers will look beyond the requested documents and medical records if they need additional validation of compliance with the standards. The Prereview Questionnaire (PRQ) provides Reviewers with an overview of the program and serves as a guide for the review process. For planning purposes, the review will last approximately 12 to 14 hours over a two-day period.

This document should be used in conjunction with the Site Visit Agenda and Site Visit Manual which are posted in the ACS Quality Portal (QPort).
