






Participating Programs

- 366 total programs
 - 292 had patients with 3 or more missed appts (79.8%)

Type of Program	N (%)
Academic	41 (11.2%)
Comprehensive Community	99 (27.0%)
Community Cancer Program	60 (16.4%)
Integrated Network	110 (30.1%)
Other	56 (15.3%)

Baseline Systems in Place

No System = **1.8%**



Total Disease Site Submissions

- 837 total submissions across all disease sites
 - Median # of submissions per program= 2 (IQR 1-4)
 - 463 had patients with 3 or more missed appts (55.3%)



Rate of 3 or More Missed Appointments All Disease Site Submissions

- Including submissions with zero missed appointments
 - Median 3.7% (IQR 0-16.7)
- Excluding submissions with zero missed appointments
 - Median 14.3% (IQR 7.7-29.3)

Rate of 3 or More Missed Appointments By Individual Program


- Including programs with zero missed appointments
 - Median 7.1% (IQR 0-13.8)
- Excluding programs with zero missed appointments
 - Median 9.8% (IQR 5.4-16.1)




Missed Appointments by Disease Site

Disease Site	Submissions (N)	Patients (N)	Median (IQR)
Breast	105	242	7.7% (4.8-14.3)
GI	17	37	50% (18.2-50)
GYN	20	34	22.5% (14.3-50)
H&N	87	183	22.2% (11.1-38.5)
Prostate	65	122	10.5% (7.1-20)
Lung	63	113	20% (10-30)
Rectum	27	34	50% (25-50)


Reasons for Missed Appointments









Common Questions

- Do I have to report and separate out by disease site?
- Many of our patients don't miss 3 visits. Can I submit data on 2 or more missed visits instead?
- Data collection is taking awhile because I don't know how to pull reports from my software. Can you help?
- The reason my patient "no-showed" is not listed in the REDCap form.
 What now?
- Should I include cancel? Or only no show? My report differentiates
