

2026 CoC State Chair Outstanding Performance Award

The annual Commission on Cancer (CoC) State Chair Outstanding Performance Award recognizes individuals who exhibit outstanding leadership and innovation, and who make significant contributions to the improvement of cancer care in his or her state or region.

CRITERIA

The winners of the 2026 Outstanding Performance Award are chosen based on their accomplishments and activities during 2025, as reported in the annual State Chair Activity Report.

To be considered a candidate for the Outstanding Performance Award, State Chairs must meet all Tier One activities:
