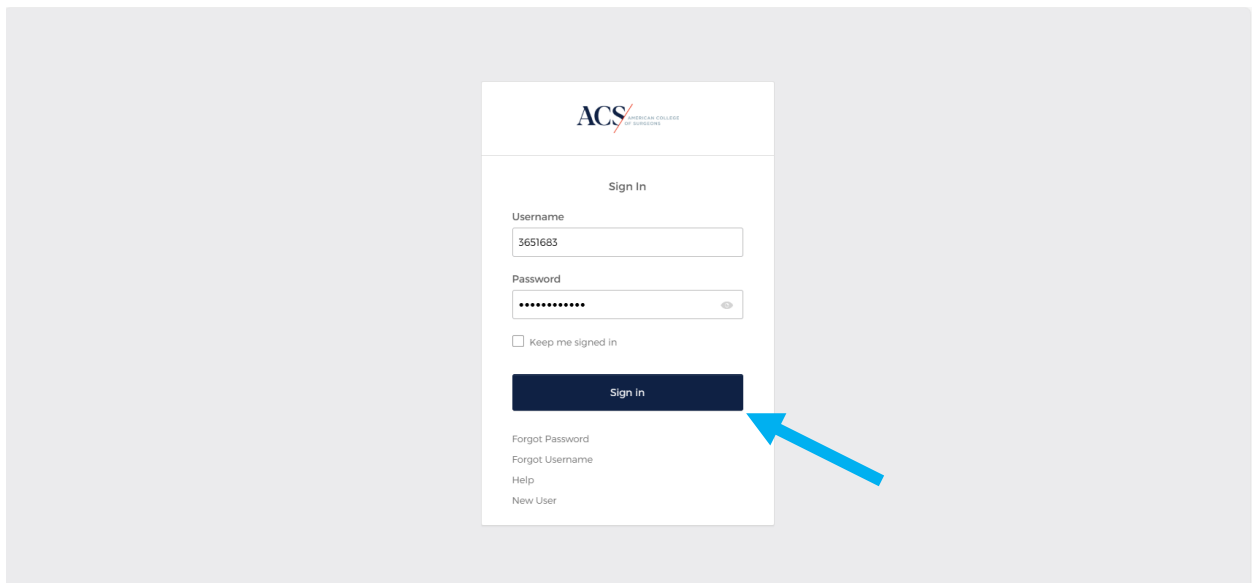
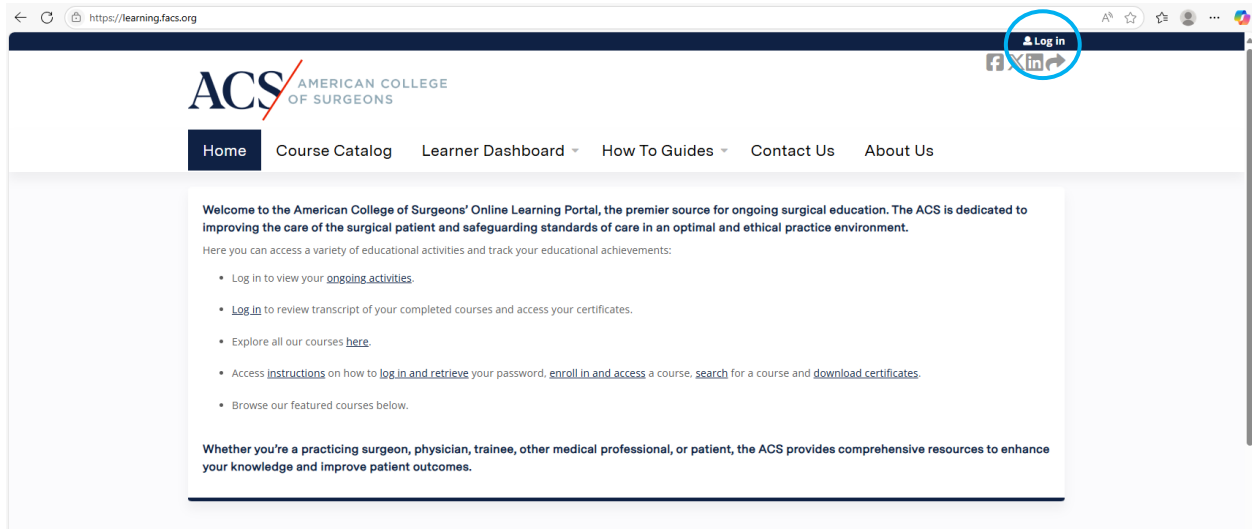
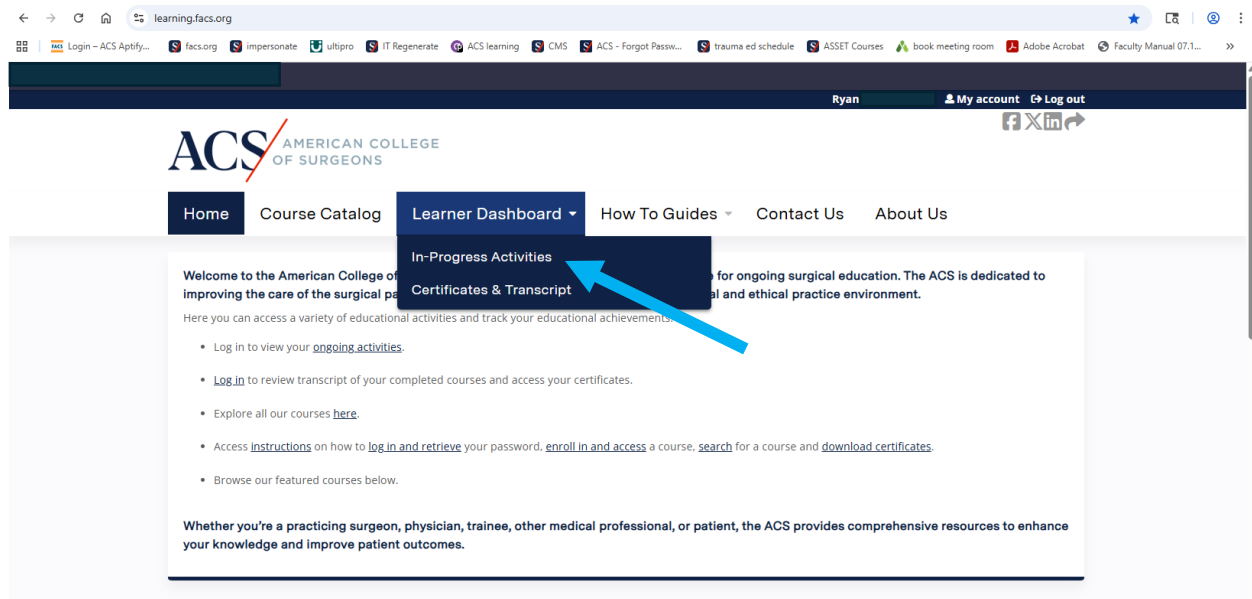


This guide will show you how to claim credit after successfully completing your ATLS 11 course.

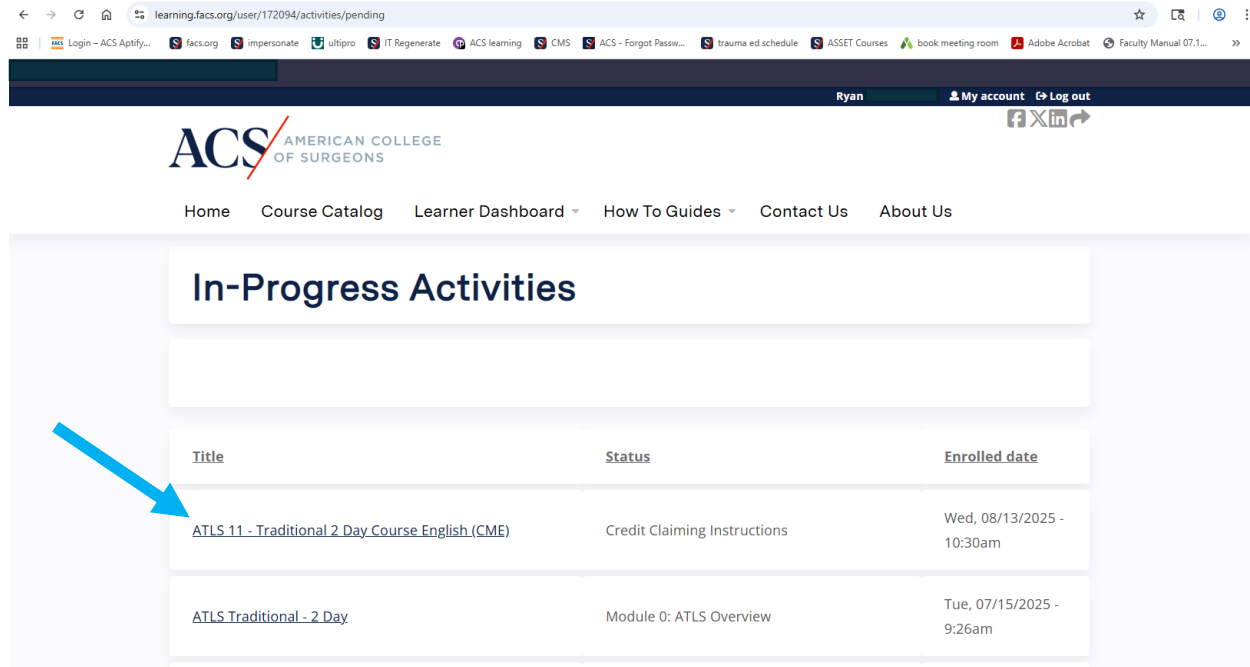
1. Navigate to <https://learning.facs.org/> and login using your credentials:



2. Once successfully logged in, hover over the “Learner Dashboard” tab and click on “In-Progress Activities”:



- You will see your courses listed on the “In-Progress Activities” table. Click on the one in which you want to claim credit:

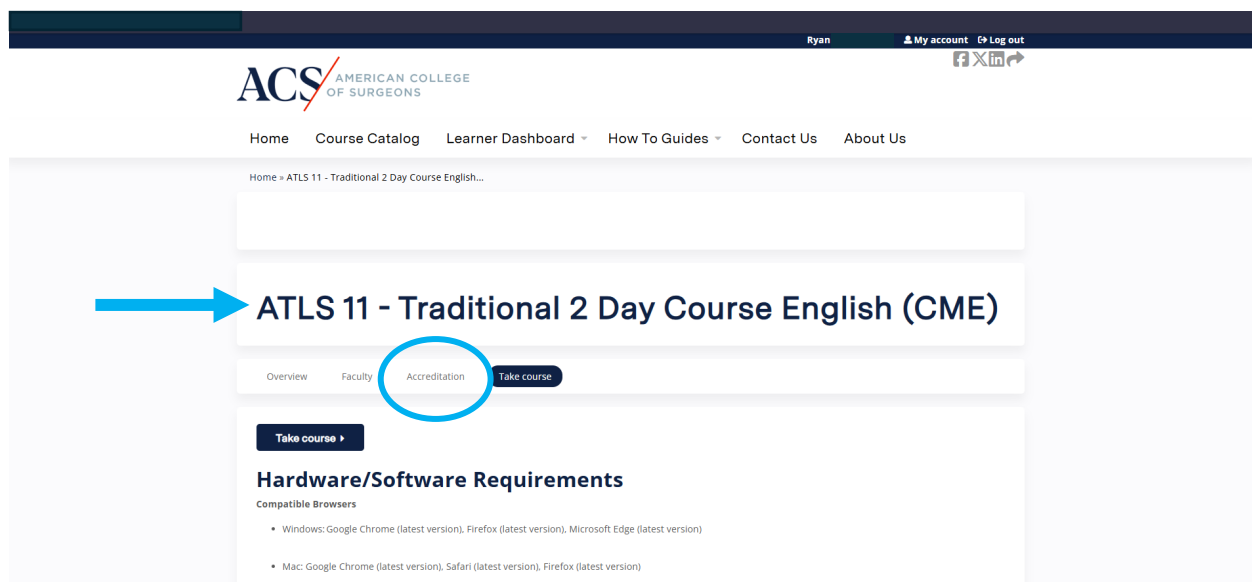

Tip:

- In this example, we will be claiming credit for the ATLS 11 Traditional 2 Day Course English (CME). Pay close attention to the status of the course in which you want to claim credit. If the status of the course is not currently in “Credit Claiming Instructions” you will not be able to claim credit and will need to contact the Site Coordinator where you took the course for assistance.



4. You have now entered the specific course profile. Click on the “Accreditation” tab for information regarding total amount of Continuing Medical Education (CME) Credit, Self-Assessment (SA) Credit and Regulatory Mandate (RM) Credit offered for this specific course and about transferring CME credits to the American Board of Surgery (ABS):

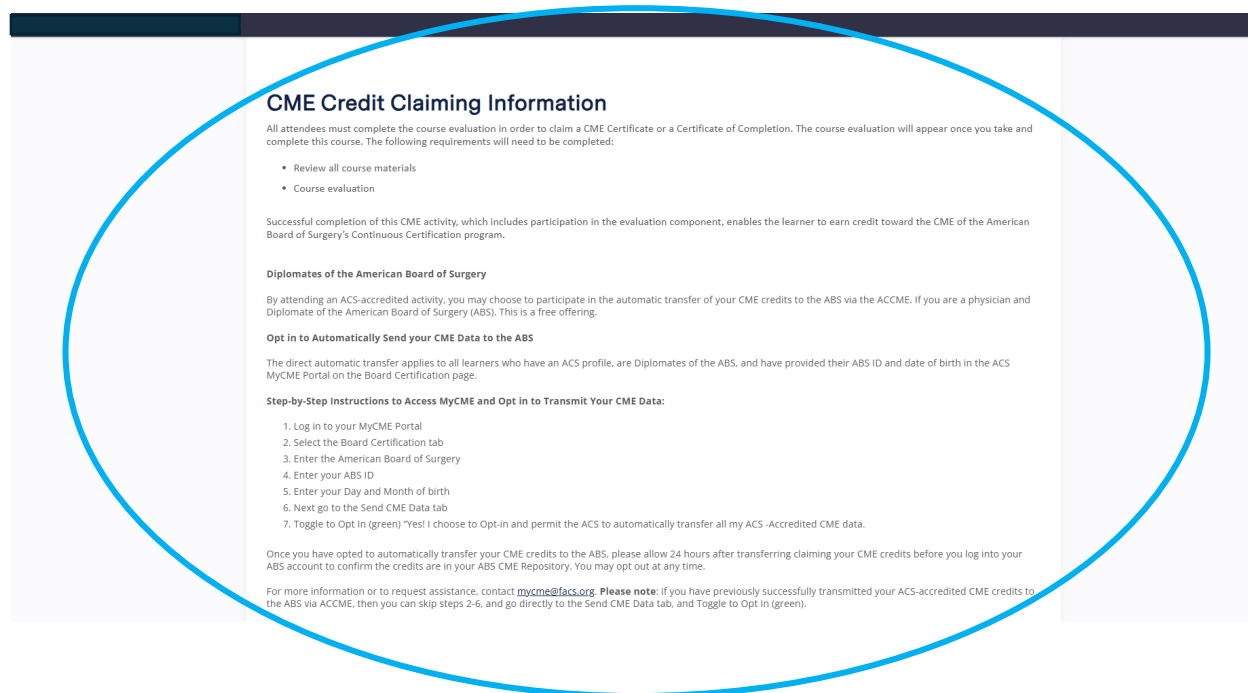

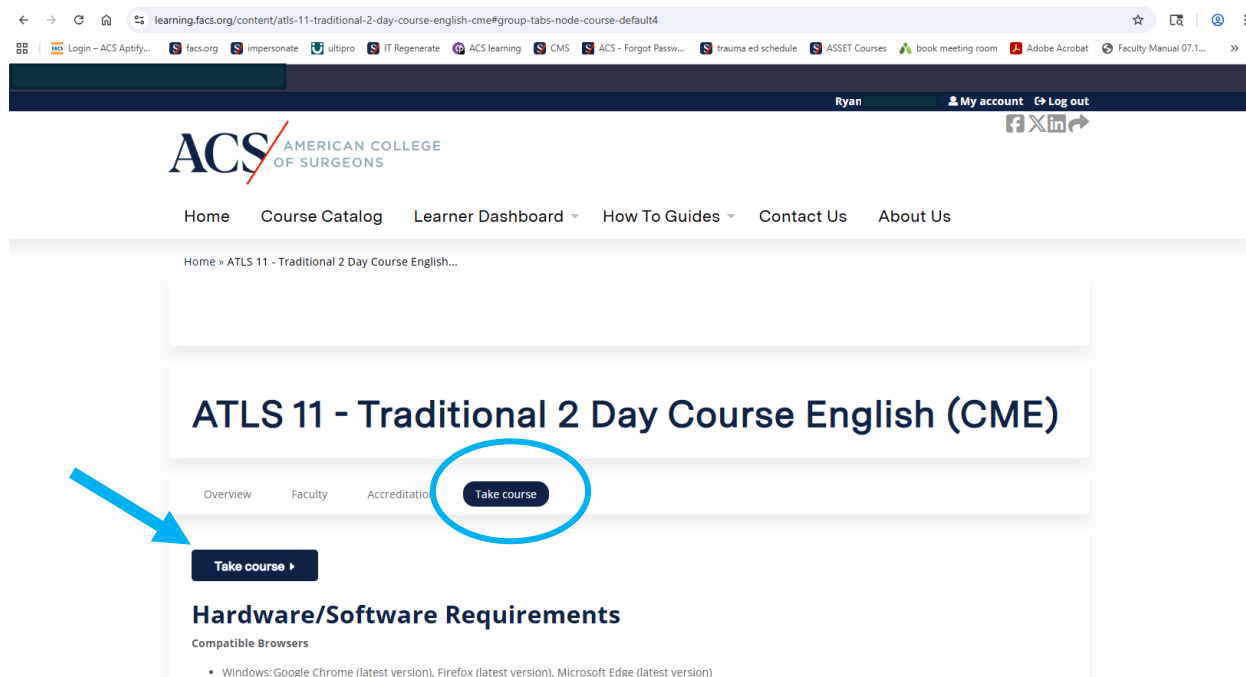

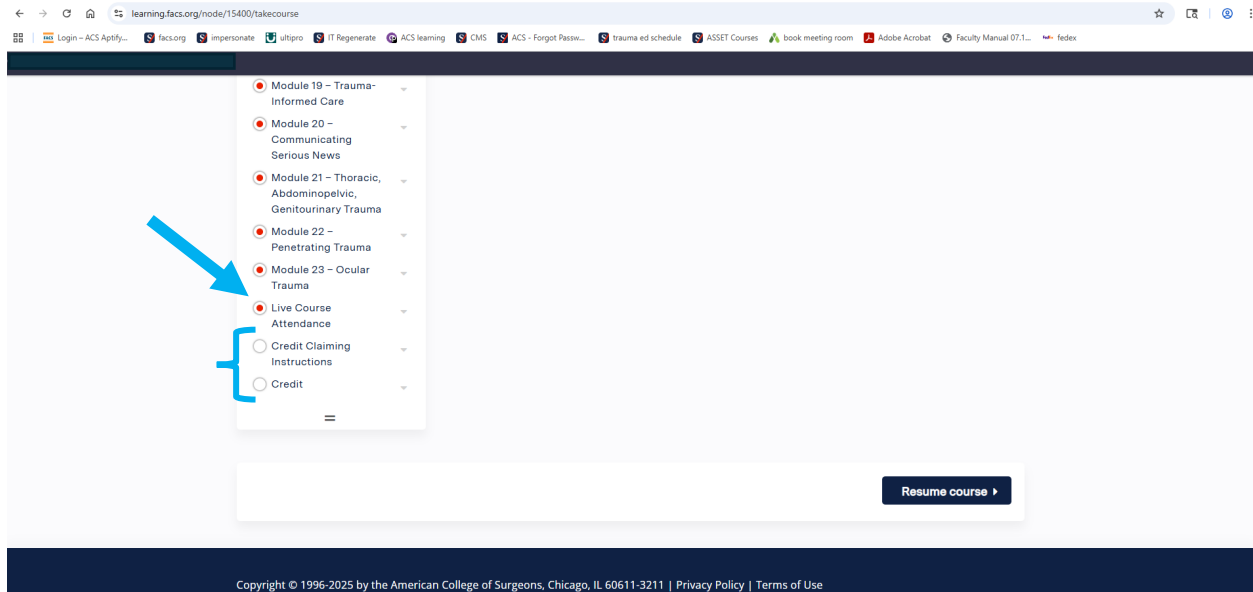

7. Once the accreditation information has been reviewed, navigate to the “Take Course” tab and click on the “Take Course” button to enter the course:

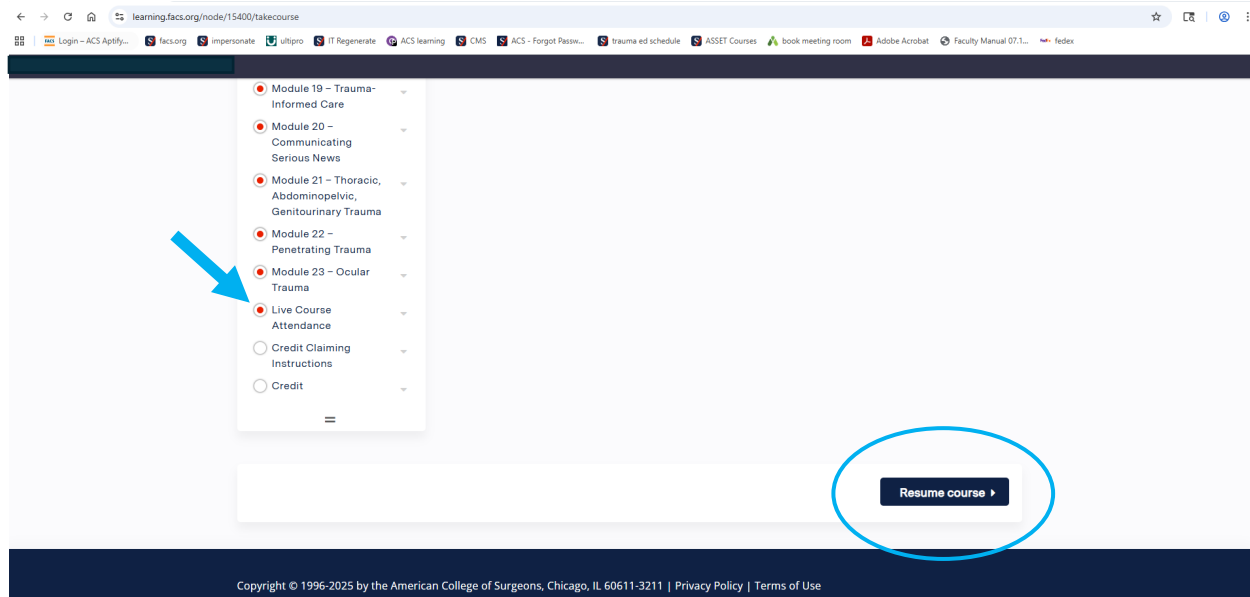

Credit Claiming Instructions

The ATLS 11 Traditional 2 Day Course offers attendees continuing education credits for their participation in this activity. Physicians are eligible to claim CME credits. All other attendees can claim a Certificate of Participation.
