

<b>Date Position Begins:</b>	Immediately upon appointment.
<b>Appointment Term:</b>	Membership terms are for two years and run October - September. There is potential for reappointment for two additional 2-year terms.
<b>Membership Requirement:</b>	Must be a current VRC Site Visit Reviewer, with a minimum of 1 year experience.
<b>Participation Structure:</b>	Workgroup sits within the Quality Program Area, within Verification, Review, and Consultation.
<b>Anticipated Duration:</b>	Standing committee/workgroup.
<b>Effort Requirement:</b>	Approximately 5-7 hours per month via independent work; Attendance at periodic virtual meetings, in addition to participating in the required number of site visits per year.
<b>Experience/Skills Desired:</b>	Workgroup members will be current VRC Reviewers representing multiple disciplines including adult and pediatric trauma surgeons, neurosurgeons, orthopaedic surgeons, and trauma nurses. We will strive to create a balance of experience, including lead, associate, and other reviewers.

#### **VRC Post Site Review Workgroup Overview**

Members of this Post Site Review Workgroup will perform a secondary clinical review of draft reports completed by Trauma VRC reviewers who conduct site visits of trauma centers. Following this review, workgroup members will make a recommendation to the VRC to approve the report or to make changes.

#### **VRC Post Site Review Workgroup Deliverable(s)**

- Review draft reports to:
  - Ensure consistency between each reviewer comment and rating, and confirm correct and consistent application and interpretation of the standards published in the current edition of the Resources for Optimal Care of the Injured Patient.
- Receive no more than 3 reports per week and complete each review within a one-week turnaround time.
- Maintain an 80% response rate.
