

# **Staging Classifications**



- Stage defined at number of points in care of the cancer patient
- Points in time are called classifications





# **Staging Classifications**



#### Clinical

- Used for making treatment decisions
- Evaluate treatment choices
- Only point in time to compare all cancer patients

### Pathological

- Adjuvant treatment planning
- More precise data
- Estimate prognosis
- Calculate end results

### Posttherapy Clinical

- Clinical assessment of response to neoadjuvant therapy
- Determines appropriate surgical resection

## Posttherapy Pathological

- Provide response to therapy
- Guides further adjuvant radiation and/or systemic therapy



#### Clinical Classification



- Clinical staging includes information
  - Prior to any definitive treatment (or no Rx decision)
  - Or within 4 months
  - Whichever is shorter
- Not changed by subsequent information
- Clinical staging is same as pre-treatment staging



#### Clinical Classification



- Eligible information is diagnostic workup
- Diagnostic workup includes
  - Physical exam
  - Imaging studies
  - Lab tests
  - Biopsy of primary site
  - Biopsy of lymph node
  - Biopsy of sentinel nodes
  - Biopsy of a metastatic site
- Clinical stage used to
  - Review treatment guidelines
  - Develop treatment plan



# **Pathological Classification**



- Pathological staging includes information
  - Through completion of definitive surgery (1st course Rx)
  - Or within 4 months
  - Whichever is longer
  - But no systemic or radiation therapy initiated
  - No clear disease progression



# **Pathological Classification**



## Eligible information

- All information
- Clinical staging info combined with
- Surgical/operative findings (operative report) and
- Exam of resected tissue (pathology report) required

## Pathological stage

- Develop plans for adjuvant treatment
- Prognosis and outcome



# Posttherapy Classification



- Measures response to therapy
  - Prognostic
  - Guides subsequent surgery or other therapy
- yc
- Clinical staging after systemic/radiation Rx
- yp
- Pathological staging after systemic/radiation Rx/surgery



# Posttherapy Clinical Classification



# Timing

- After neoadjuvant therapy
- Before planned surgery

## Eligible information

- Clinical history and physical examination
- Any imaging studies
- Any diagnostic procedures including biopsies



# Posttherapy Pathological Classification



#### Timing

- After neoadjuvant therapy including surgery
- Systemic/radiation Rx must be primary therapy
- Eligible information
  - All information
  - Posttherapy clinical info combined with
  - Surgical/operative findings (operative report) and
  - Exam of resected tissue (pathology report) required
- No residual cancer
  - ypT0 ypN0 cM0
  - No stage group is assigned
