## ANAMNESIS

THE CONCEPTION of the Bizerte County Medical Society in September 1943, was a happy one, since its playful parents sought only companionable recreation and an antidote for cerebral stagnation. The enthusiasm with which the early clandestine meetings were attended was such that they soon became legitemized by local officialdom. Whether this last factor was psychologically responsible for the events losing their classification as sporting, or whether enforced inclusion of long dissertations upon medical supply and the composition of "C" boards proved unpalatable, is now immaterial. In any case the infant succumbed rapidly to anoxic miasm.

Certain of the sponsors were keenly disappointed in this outcome, for they believed that such meetings could be both happy and profitable. Fortunately, these gatherings were encouraged and far better organized as the war went on. The relatively narrow fronts, the changing dispositions of hospitals, as well as the periodic phases of relative inactivity, tended to make acquaintances wide. In time, many of us could count close friends by the dozen, all over the theatre. Then, suddenly, the war was over. Some way had to be found to keep track.

The summer of '45 found a group of itinerant surgeons turned penpushers at Casserta. There, day after long, weary day was spent composing reports for which the surgical world presumably was eagerly waiting, and which were destined, like some dainty submarine flowers, to bloom unseen in the dark caverns of the Surgeon General's archives. About 2 P.M. it would often so happen that someone like Oscar Hampton or Jim Mason would discover that he had transportation to the Mondragone beach, and the evacuation was not infrequently so precipitious that even the Surgical Consultant's table was overturned in the rush for the exit. Again, the exigencies of circumstance might require our presence in Napoli towards the end of an afternoon, and it was only natural, that advantage be taken of the hospitality of the Villa Galotti. Sitting there on the high veranda, with Vesuvius and the Bay of Naples as a back drop, it was inevitable that good company, good food, and a few flasks of Falernian wine should produce good talk.


It was in this atmosphere that The Excelsior Surgical Club was born. A number of us were familiar with the Eclat Club, and thanks to Doctors Harvey Stone and Billy Fisher, its exact pattern became available. As an added attraction the organization was made coeducational. The name was a natural, since it was at the Excelsior Hotel in Rome that Howard Snyder and the rest of the Fifth Army once broke training. The plan was twofold: In general, a meeting was to be held each year, preferably in the fall at a medical center which would be asked to put on a program. It might so happen that a good athletic contest as, for example, a football game, would be held in the neighborhood on the last day of the meeting. On that evening, it would appear appropriate further to break training with a cocktail party and dinner at which some form of entertainment might be provided.

The second and equally important part of the plan was to show our appreciation for Colonel Churchill's outstanding contribution to the surgery of the Mediterranean Theater by founding a lectureship in his honor. This was to be given at each annual meeting.

After organizing in New York in February 1946, the first regular meeting was held at Boston the following autumn. It was indeed fortuitous that this coincided with the last gathering of the Ećlat Club. None of us shall ever forget that distinguished group as they filed in to sit with us at our first session. Never had the spirit of two groups of men seemed more identical.

# A Tribute to the Surgeons of the Mediterranean Theater

# IN THE SURGICAL MANAGEMENT OF THE WOUNDED THIS THEATER HAS:

Demonstrated that military surgery need not be a crude departure from accepted surgical standards — but may be a development of the science of surgery to carry out a specialized and highly significant mission.

Established continuity in the professional procedures that govern the management of the wounded soldier from the time the missile strikes to the complete repair of the damage it has caused.

Shown that the essentials of wound treatment are found in prompt emergency treatment, complete initial surgery and early reparative surgery.

Introduced the concept of reparative surgery — a new and far reaching development of wound management.

Originated the transfer of selected cases of the most seriously wounded to a surgical (Field) hospital adjacent to the divisional clearing station and established the highest standards of surgical treatment at this forward point.

Maintained the strength of the fighting force by prompt and expert surgical treatment of the lightly wounded combat soldier within the Army area.

Clarified the nature of shock in wounded men and demonstrated that an adequate supply of fresh whole blood for resuscitation from shock is essential to forward surgery.

Designed and trained blood procurement and distribution organizations that have provided over 70,000 pints of whole blood from within the Theater.

Introduced the new agent penicillin into large scale use in military surgery as a potent adjunct to wound management.

Eliminated the scourge of infection as a common complication of war wounds.

Developed and standardized effective, comfortable and safe methods of transportation splinting.

Reduced the incidence of crippling and permanent disability in wounds of major joints and bones by early and radical operative treatment combined with penicillin.

Dispelled the fear of gas gangrene as any but a rare complication of severe wounds.

Changed the focal center in wounds of the chest from the treatment of septic complications of these formidable injuries to a rapid and complete re-expansion of the lung and early restoration of the functional integrity of the respiratory system.

Reduced the mortality rate and incidence of complications in all special fields of surgery—abdominal, cranio-cerebral, maxillo-facial, etc.

Pioneered in the large scale evacuation of wounded by C-47's, establishing thereby a close link between forward and rear hospitals.

Introduced sodium pentothal as one of the three most important anaesthetic agents of military surgery by a clear definition of its limitations and a reduction in the hazards that initially attended its use.

Standardized for military use a simple, comfortable and effective treatment for burns.

Collected and recorded technical data under the pressure of heavy loads of routine work, in order that this data might be made available to other theaters of less experience.

These, in part, have been your achievements, but you have not accomplished these things unaided. You have had the assistance of an alert command; of a cooperative administration, deeply concerned with the welfare of the patient; of an efficient supply system, moving tons of equipment so that you and your patients would lack no essentials; of a corps of skilled nurses sharing long and arduous hours; of professional associates carrying on the essential tasks of the shock ward, the laboratory, the X-ray dark room and other duties removed from the drama and flood-lights of the operating table; of the "Medics" who rescued your patients from the battlefield; of the battalion surgeons and the medical officers in the field who by expert emergency treatment have brought living patients to your care; of dietitians, physiotherapists, technicians of all grades and skills and countless other helpers who make up the team with which you have worked. To these gratitude is expressed for making your work possible. To you we express pride for proving yourselves worthy of their support.
