

**Lisa McElroy, MD, MS, FACS | Duke University**

Dr. McElroy is an abdominal transplant surgeon and health services researcher at Duke University, where she is an Assistant Professor in the departments of Surgery and Population Health Sciences. She received her research training via a T32 postdoctoral research fellowship at Northwestern University, where she also earned a Master of Science in Health Services and Outcomes Research through the Institute for Public Health and Medicine. Dr. McElroy's research examines the influence of organizational characteristics on clinical outcomes of high cost, high acuity patients. Her current research projects, which aim to improve equity in access to transplantation by reducing bias in processes of care, are funded by the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, the American Surgical Association Foundation, and the National Institutes of Health.
