DIABETIC PATIENTS

Perioperative management: Will the patient be NPO after midnight?

Is the patient having bowel prep?

If YES, while NPO and during prep:

- □ Stop all diabetic medications except for pioglitazone (Actos)
- \Box Reduce (Lantus) by 50%
- Check blood sugars frequently and use sliding scale as needed
